3. Introduction

3.1 Under the sponsorship of the Safety Management Section Air Navigation Bureau of ICAO Headquarters, a Safety Intelligence and Safety Performance Management workshop was held in the facilities of Central American Corporation for Air Navigation Services (COCESNA) Central American Aviation Safety Agency (ACSA), San Jose, Costa Rica, from 18 to 22 March 2024, for the States from NAM/CAR/SAM Regions. The workshop was facilitated by Mr. Marcelo Orellana, Regional Officer, Safety Implementation from the ICAO NACC Regional Office and delivered jointly by Mrs. Manoosh Valipour and Mrs. Ruviana Zimmerman from the Safety Management Section Air Navigation Bureau of ICAO.

3.2 The Workshop had 37 participants from the NAM/CAR/SAM Regions and one Regional Safety Oversight Organization. The workshop was well received and highly appreciated by the participants, whose feedback confirmed that the event was informative, relevant, and timely, which will greatly help attendees and their colleagues to have a better understanding of safety intelligence and its application in safety management systems within the states and at a regional level.

4. Outcomes/Recommendations

- 4.1 The Workshop aimed to equip participants with knowledge and practical skills related to safety intelligence and performance management. Here are the key outcomes:
 - To understand data importance.
 - To gain insights into the significance of data for managing safety and making informed decisions.
 - To develop a Safety Intelligence Strategy.
 - To provide guidance on creating effective safety intelligence strategies.
 - To monitor and to manage safety performance.
 - To learn techniques for monitoring safety performance and implementing necessary improvements.
- 4.2 The ICAO NACC Regional Office recommends that participants:
 - implement all the knowledge and skills obtained within the SSP Working Group and at a regional level; and
 - develop an action plan for their State and indicate the actions they will take after the workshop.
