# Provision of relevant information regarding the aircraft and flight crew

Has the State established and implemented procedures to ensure that it provides the State conducting the investigation with, as applicable, any relevant information regarding the aircraft and flight crew involved in an aircraft accident or serious incident as soon as possible?

## Key elements:

- 1. Established and implemented
- 2. Provides the State
  - Relevant information regarding the aircraft and flight crew
- 4. As soon as possible

## Established and implemented

- This PQ requires evidence of implementation
- Evidence = message to the State that sent the notification

### **Provides the State**

- Letter, email, fax, phone, etc.
- May be connected with PQs 6.325 and 6.329

## Relevant information regarding the aircraft and flight crew

- Relevant regarding aircraft includes
  - Maintenance recordsCondition before flight
  - Polovant rogarding flight crow include
- Relevant regarding flight crew includes
  - Qualification/experience/training
  - Rest before flight
  - Medical conditions

## As soon as possible

- That means at the first moment where the information can be sent
- It is different from "as soon as practicable"
- A reasonable limit shall be establish to wait for complete information

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4.6 Upon receipt of the notification, the State of Registry, the State of the Operator, the State of Design and the State of Manufacture shall, as soon as possible, provide the State of Occurrence with any relevant information available to them regarding the aircraft and flight crew involved in the accident or incident. Each State shall also inform the State of Occurrence whether it intends to appoint an accredited representative and if such an accredited representative is appointed, the name and contact details; as well as the expected date of arrival if the accredited representative will travel to the State of Occurrence.

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INTERNATIONAL CIVIL AVIATION ORGANIZATION

4.10 Upon receipt of the notification, the State of the Operator, the State of Design and the State of Manufacture shall, upon request, provide the State of Registry with any relevant information available to them regarding the flight crew and the aircraft involved in the accident or incident. Fach State shall also inform the State of Registry whether it intends to appoint an accredited representative, and if such an accredited representative is appointed, the name and contact details; as well as the expected date of arrival if the accredited representative will be present at the investigation.

#### **5.4 RESPONSE TO NOTIFICATIONS**

- 5.4.3 The following specific requirements of ICAO Annex 13, Chapter 4, are policy provisions of the [Accident Investigation Authority]:
- The [Accident Investigation Authority] should provide the State conducting the investigation with, as applicable, any relevant information regarding the flight, crew and aircraft involved in an accident or incident as soon as possible.

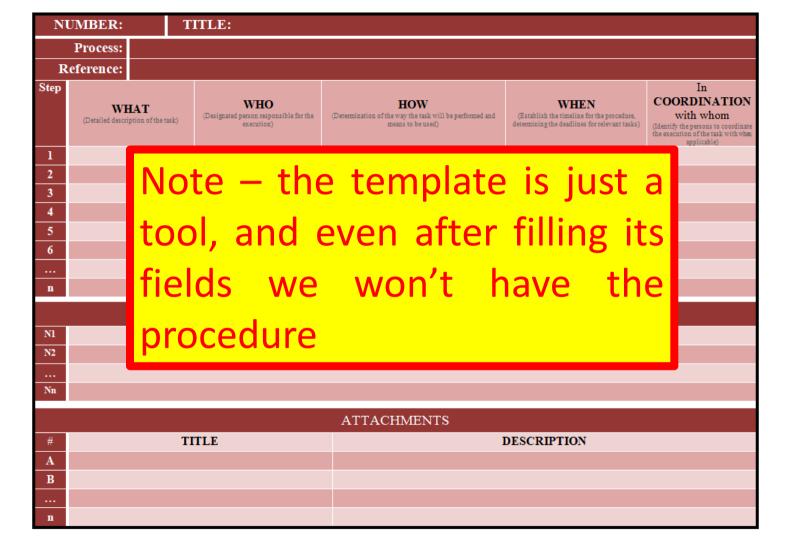



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#### PROCEDURE No 06/CAAC-AIG - PROVISION OF RELEVANT INFORMATION OF AIRCRAFT AND FLIGHT CREW

#### INTRODUCTION

As per Standards 4.6 and 4.10 of Annex 13, Coronaland shall provide the State conducting the investigation with any relevant information available to them regarding the aircraft and flight crew involved in the accident or incident.

This procedure aims at complying with such requirement.

#### PROCEDURE

- 1 The accredited representative will, as soon as possible and in no longer than 3 hours after the receipt of the notification, log into the CAAC database to gather all relevant information regarding:
  - The aircraft, to feed the Form 06/AIG (Relevant information regarding aircraft); and
  - The flight crew, to feed the Form 07/AIG (Relevant information regarding flight crew). Note: When an accredited representative has not been appointed, the Investigator on duty becomes responsible

for this task. 2 The accredited representative will, as soon as possible and in no longer than 5 hours after the receipt

of the notification, prepare the communication email to the State to forward the Forms O6/AIG and 07/AIG
