SUMMARY

This working paper presents to the Meeting a summary and the Conclusions of the first meeting and the Terms of Reference and work programme of the ICAO/LACAC NAM/CAR/SAM Aviation Security and Facilitation Regional Group (AVSEC/FAL/RG), for review and consideration.

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1. Introduction

1.1 During the GREPECAS Tenth Meeting held in Las Palmas, Canary Islands, Spain, in October 2011, the creation of the Aviation Security Committee (AVSEC/COMM) was approved. Since August 2002 until July 2008 this Committee met in 6 opportunities, and with the support of experts from different States completed several tasks in benefit of the NAM/CAR and SAM regions.

1.2 During ICAO Council meeting held on 18 March 2008, conclusions of Working Paper C-W/13135 were revised, presented by the Chairperson of the Air Navigation Commission (ANC). The Council agreed to maintain the terms of reference of the Implementation Regional Groups (PIRG), with the exception of CAR/SAM Regional groups (GREPECAS), which terms of reference were amended to exclude the aviation security issues from the GREPECAS mechanism, due to the reason that the ANC is not the proper entity to for handling this matter.

1.3 Therefore, and due to the importance of continuing with this important activities, and as result of a proposal presented by AVSEC/COMM/6 Conclusions, approved during GREPECAS/16 Meeting, held in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, in October 2008. With the purpose of replacing the former GREPECAS Aviation Security Committee (AVSEC/COMM), the ICAO NAM/CAR/SAM Regional Group for Aviation Security and Facilitation (AVSEC/FAL/RG) was created, which was endorsed by Conclusion 11/11.c) of the RAAC/11 Meeting. The AVSEC/FAL/RG had its first meeting in May 2010 in Trinidad and Tobago. Subsequently, and as result of the cooperation agreement signed between ICAO and LACAC, this group joined with the LACAC FAL/AVSEC Group.

1.4 The new ICAO/LACAC NAM/CAR/SAM Aviation Security and Facilitation Regional Group (AVSEC/FAL/RG) held its first meeting in Asuncion, Paraguay, from 25 to 27 May 2011. Among the various matters considered during the first meeting of the AVSEC/FAL/RG, was the development and adoption of the Terms of Reference and work programme. The Meeting was attended by 55 delegates from Argentina, Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, Honduras, Jamaica, Nicaragua, Panama, Paraguay, Suriname, Trinidad and Tobago, United States, Uruguay and Venezuela and one International Organization, ECCAA. The conclusions of the meeting are presented in **Appendix A** to this paper.

1.5 The Secretariat recalled that the AVSEC/FAL/RG was established to:

- Consolidate regional AVSEC/FAL activities to avoid duplication for enhanced efficiency
- Combine resources from States, ICAO and LACAC for greater effectiveness

1.6 The key objectives of the AVSEC/FAL/RG include the following:

- Foster regional harmonized implementation of AVSEC/FAL requirements
- Encourage and facilitate cooperation between States
- Support the identification, provision and coordination of assistance and training

1.7 Prior to, and in conjunction with the AVSEC/FAL/RG Meeting, the ICAO/LACAC Regional Aviation Security and Facilitation Seminar was held on 23 and 24 May 2011. The Seminar informed about current development in the Aviation Security (AVSEC) and Facilitation (FAL) fields; the assistance and training that the ICAO Implementation Support and Development Aviation Security (ISD-Sec) Section is implementing in the NAM/CAR/SAM Regions in coordination with the ICAO Regional Offices; the progress of the Facilitation and MRTD programme, among others, and the experiences of the States during the implementation of procedures to confront new emerging threats; implementation of their Corrective Action Plans; and the oversight of the AVSEC standards and regulations implemented within their States.

1.8 Seminar Principal Conclusions

- ICAO AVSEC and FAL assistance provided to States requires their active participation and counterpart contribution.
- Closer coordination is required between ICAO and other organizations, which provide AVSEC and FAL assistance to States to avoid duplication; for example, with training events.
- Region should prioritize States' training needs and ICAO should publish ASTC AVSEC course calendars earlier.

- States shall take advantage of AVSEC training fellowships by ensuring application, acceptance and processing in a timely manner.
- Professional management course should be made available in Spanish.
- ICAO FAL manual should be made available in Spanish as soon as possible.
- States should report the MRTD implementation status and progress to ICAO.
- The future establishment of additional ICAO ASTCs should consider the potential impact on existing ASTCs.
- Implementation of USAP State Corrective Action Plans should adopt a project management methodology.
- Certification of AVSEC instructors and personnel for quality control.
- Implementation of AVSEC oversight system with adequate legal framework, resources, procedures and implementation plans.
- Sharing of AVSEC and FAL best practices between States.
- Regional work should adopt collaborative groups of States and be defined in programmes and projects.
- Recognize the importance of threat assessment and risk analysis within the States
- States should consider new cargo security Standards.

2. **Discussion**

2.1 The Meeting elected the representative of Paraguay as the Chairperson of the new Group and the representative from Trinidad and Tobago as Vice-Chairperson. The Secretariat was provided by ICAO and LACAC. Within ICAO, the Secretariat will be coordinated by the Regional Officer, Aviation Security for the NAM/CAR/SAM Regions supported by ICAO Headquarters Aviation Security Branch.

2.2 The Meeting reviewed the Declaration adopted by the 37th Session of the ICAO Assembly regarding Aviation Security, the ICAO Comprehensive Aviation Security Strategy (ICASS), and the capacity building strategy for aviation security for the compliance of the ICAO AVSEC Strategic Objective and the implication of this strategy for ICAO as well as for the States; and the progress of the second audit cycle of the USAP.

2.3 The Meeting was also informed about the Assembly's adoption of a series of regional aviation security conferences planned to continue increasing the conscience regarding the support and improvement of aviation security within the ICAO member States and build on the success of regional Ministerial-level conferences held in 2010. Each conference is expected to adopt a statement/roadmap on regional aviation security enhancement, and collectively they will help build consensus prior to a global high-level conference on aviation security which will be held in 2012. Delegations should be led at a Director General level to facilitate discussions on implementation matters. A Regional Aviation Security Conference for the NAM/CAR/SAM Regions is planned to be conducted during the last quarter of 2011, in Santa Cruz de la Sierra, Bolivia, on 5-6 December 2011, and the participation of States in that event is encouraged.

2.4 Regarding the *back-up of critical documents for emergencies*, the Meeting took note of WP/17 presented by COCESNA/ACSA, which included the "*Guidelines for Management of Sensitive Aviation Security Information*" document that was developed by the Central American AVSEC experts group during their VIII Meeting held in June 2010. The Meeting agreed that the AVSEC/FAL/RG work programme include the review and revision of this information to be considered for regional application.

2.5 Honduras presented WP/20 on "*International Co-Operation Mechanisms for the Development of Corrective Measures Action Plans at a Regional Level*", which reminded States of the importance of Recommended Practice 2.4.5 of Annex 17 to share results of the USAP audits, whenever possible.

2.6 The Meeting was informed that Decision 1/3 regarding the Terms of Reference was reviewed in conjunction with LACAC. The Secretariat presented WP/05Rev. inviting the Meeting to review, revise and endorse the proposed Terms of Reference for the ICAO/LACAC NAM/CAR/SAM Aviation Security and Facilitation Regional Group (AVSEC/FAL/RG) and develop the associated work programmes and projects with reference to the LACAC FAL/AVSEC Group Terms of Reference included in the LACAC Strategic Activities Plan (2011 – 2012), the report of the Fourth Meeting of the LACAC FAL/AVSEC Group, and the Aviation Security and Facilitation Regional Group – Pan America (AVSEC/FAL/RG-PA) Terms of Reference and Action Plan.

2.7 The Secretariat proposed a work methodology for the AVSEC/FAL/RG to ensure effectiveness and efficiency based on:

- Performance-based objectives
- Implementation focus
- Group work
- Project management
- Tangible and measurable results
- State and Secretariat coordination and accountability

2.8 The Meeting established the Terms of Reference for the new regional group; and also developed a work programme consisting of 9 projects, comprised by voluntary representatives of the States. The Terms of Reference and the Work Programme are presented in the **Appendix B** to this working paper.

2.9 ECCAA (Eastern Caribbean Civil Aviation Authority) offered to host the next meeting of the group planned for May 2012, and will confirm as soon as possible the name of the member State where this event will take place, and Suriname offered to host the following meeting in 2013.

2.10 ICAO has circulated the AVSEC/FAL/RG/1 Meeting conclusions to States and Territories for approval by 30 June 2011 in the letter dated 9 June 2011 (Ref. SA355).

3. Suggested Action

3.1 The Meeting is invited to take note of the information presented in this working paper and encourage States, which did not do that yet, to consider and approve the Conclusions adopted by the first ICAO/LACAC NAM/CAR/SAM Aviation Security and Facilitation Regional Group Meeting.

AND FACILITATION REGIONAL GROUP
(AVSEC/FAL/RG)**

1. Establishment

1.1 Addressing the following meetings and agreements:

- First Meeting of the Regional Aviation Security and Facilitation Group – Pan America (AVSEC/FAL/RG-PA/1) (Port-of-Spain, Trinidad and Tobago, 12 to 14 May 2010);
- Third Meeting of the LACAC GRUFAL/AVSEC (Montevideo, Uruguay, 5 to 6 July 2010);
- Agreement from the LXXIX LACAC Executive Committee (Mexico City, Mexico, 31 August to 1 September 2010);
- Memorandum of Cooperation between ICAO and LACAC providing a framework for enhanced cooperation (Montreal, Canada, 27 September 2010);
- Resolution 19/5 of the Latin American Civil Aviation Commission XIX Ordinary Assembly (LACAC) (Punta Cana, Dominican Republic, 1 to 5 November 2010); and
- First Meeting of the Aviation Security and Facilitation Regional Group (AVSEC/FAL/RG) (Asuncion, Paraguay, 25 to 27 May 2011);

ICAO and LACAC will process the reports using their respective Secretariat and Governing Body mechanisms, as appropriate, taking into consideration the minimization of any duplication for those States, which are members of LACAC.

3.***Secretariat***

3.1 The Secretariat will be provided by ICAO and LACAC. Within ICAO, the Secretariat will be led by the NACC and SAM Regional Offices coordinated by the Regional Officer, Aviation Security for the NAM/CAR/SAM Regions, and supported by the ICAO Headquarters Aviation Security Branch.

4***Strategy***

- 4.1 Emphasize the importance of aviation security amongst States and stakeholders.
- 4.2 Promote compliance with security provisions and aviation security oversight capability of States.
- 4.3 Promote the sharing of information amongst States to raise awareness of threats and aviation security trends.
- 4.4 Promote mutual recognition of aviation security processes.

5.***Objectives***

5.1 Enhance the security and facilitation of air transport operations, aircraft, civil aviation installations, personnel and travelling public, and discourage and diminish the potential for unlawful interference and acts against civil aviation.

5.2 Improve regulation and enforcement of aviation security provisions by appropriate authorities at the national level, and security arrangements and implementation capability at international airports in the States.

5.3 Develop a regional aviation security structure or entity for regional cooperation and coordination in aviation security assistance for States.

5.4 Establish a regional mechanism that allows having “common application” guidelines of Annexes 9 and 17, paying special attention to the generation of a regional policy for the organization, application and compliance of international standards of the National Committees and Facilitation and Security Airport Committees.

5.5 Strengthen the coordination, cooperation and exchange mechanisms of information, experiences, procedures and best practices in aviation security and facilitation among States; strengthen the AVSEC and FAL oversight systems on behalf of States competent Authorities, as well as the harmonization of FAL/AVSEC training programmes and policies on the basis of individual needs in each region.

5.6 Develop training guidelines to maintain AVSEC/FAL balance and a proper methodology that allows States to assess and define threat levels and its harmonization whenever the circumstances allow it.

5.7 Develop a cooperation policy, oriented to the compliance of standards contained in Annex 9 – Facilitation on the implementation of machine readable travel documents (MRTDs).

5.8 Look for intraregional support alternatives to harmonize effective and efficient implementation of AVSEC and FAL standards in each State.

5.9 Identify financial and in-kind contributions from multinational and bilateral partners/donor States/Organizations to provide assistance to States with aviation security provision implementation.

5.10 Enhance awareness of the AVSEC profession.

6. Activities

6.1 Provide a forum for discussion, coordination and cooperation of aviation security and facilitation issues amongst the States, partners, and stakeholders; exchange of relevant information; and threat and risk assessment.

6.2 Review analyses of regional trends in security and facilitation deficiencies and develop harmonized regional action plans for their resolution.


6.3 Promote and provide a mechanism for regional coordination and cooperation amongst State aviation security and facilitation authorities, international organizations, regional oversight bodies and industry.

6.4 Share ‘best practices’ amongst States and utilize the capacity available in some States/Administrations to assist others.

6.5 Options available for providing assistance to and cooperation between States include the following:

- Direct bilateral and multilateral agreements between States
- Horizontal cooperation facilitated by the LACAC Secretariat
- ICAO Regional Offices with the support of and in coordination with the Implementation Support and Development – Security Section and the Technical Cooperation Bureau
- Other international organizations and development agencies
