1. Introduction

1.1 Between 8 to 9 June 2016 the Sixth Meeting of the ICAO/LACAC NAM/CAR and SAM Aviation Security and Facilitation Regional Group (AVSEC/FAL/RG/6) was held in Mexico City, Mexico. Cuba, acting as Coordinator State of the project LIST OF ARTICLES RESTRICTED BY OTHER AUTHORITIES THAN THE ONES RELATED TO AVIATION SECURITY, presented WP/15. In compliance with the first phase, that consisted in data gathering provided by States based to the replies to State Letter NT-NT1-18 – E. OSG – NACC67634 Project: Questionnaire on articles restricted by other authorities than the ones related to aviation security – AVSEC/FAL/RG, only data from eight States was collected.

2. Developed activities

2.1 As soon as the abovementioned State Letter was delivered, replies were received from States and we started a registry (Attachment A) to gather, in a general way, the received data. To determine the different indicators of this registry we took into account common aspects of the request. We took in consideration each received data and analysed carefully each answer. In this analysis, we detected some issues that should be highlighted:

- a. The request was not completely understood, which result in the sending of a Customs Declaration model
- b. In some cases, question three of the Questionnaire was interpret as if only was needed to mark the items provided in the chart, and no to also mention which products or categories of the objects are mentioned in the corresponding legislation.

2.2 In the framework of the review of the replies sent by the States, we could see that objects prohibited by other authorities than the ones related to aviation security can be organized in categories with common elements of the States to, in that way, create an effective list of restricted objects.

2.3 The goal of the project is the creation of a database with the information related to objects that are restricted by facilitation authorities, and has the objective to compile answers from States and share them through the webpage.

3. Suggested actions

3.1 The Meeting is invited to:

- a) Take note of the information provided in this working paper
- b) Request the States to finish the process and complete and send the survey of State Letter NT-NT1-18 – E.OSG – NACC67634 Project: Questionnaire on articles restricted by other authorities than the ones related to aviation security – AVSEC/FAL/RG
- c) Support the continuity of the foreseen activities of the working group, and
- d) Reaffirm the participation of the States of this Group, and invite other States to make nominations.
