1. Introduction

1.1 Annex 15 presents the digital data sets that should be part of the AIP presentation in electronic format (e-AIP).

1.2 Doc. 10066 presents the technical and procedural guidelines for the implementation of digital data sets (DDS).

1.3 During the SAM/AIM/13 Meeting, a seminar on e-AIP, AIXM and SWIM took place.

2. Discussion

2.1 At the seminar on e-AIP and SWIM carried out during SAM/AIM/13, the States took note of the information and implementation strategies referred to in the presentations offered by the delegate of the State of Uruguay and industry leaders.

2.2 The States considered that the information provided on the Digital Data Sets (DDS), Data Catalogs, e-AIP, SWIM would help them to accelerate the implementation processes of the digital phase of AIM. Likewise, they will consider the effective strategies transmitted by the industry leaders.

2.3 The Secretariat made the recordings of the Seminar available to the States for dissemination among interested parties.

2.4 The Secretariat has prepared a Table for monitoring the elements that enable the preparation of the e-AIP. The Secretariat asks the States to provide information to include it in the Table.
