CMA Online framework is....




- ☐ A suite of web-integrated applications and centralized database systems to support the implementation of CMA activities, which includes:
 - ✓ Collection of safety-related information and documents from different sources
 - ✓ Monitoring and reporting of safety oversight activities by Member States





- ☐ Respond to MIR in a timely manner






State Dashboard

Access Control



□ NCMCs

- ✓ Have a full control of user accounts for the State

☐ User account

☐ Access rights

- ✓ 3 types (no access, read-only or read/write)
- ✓ CC/EFOD : access rights can be granted per Annex
- ✓ PQ, CAP and F&R : access rights are permitted for all technical areas

☐ States

✓ Complete and update answers to questions of State Profile and SAAQ

- Most errors/feedback received from users have been addressed
- New feature to download and print completed SAAQ is under development





- ✓ Downloadable and can be worked on offline and put back into online system
- **☐** Electronic Supplements Available


- ✓ Feature that users can search difference information by Annex provision and/or by States
- **☐** Validation feature Being tested
- ✓ Support workflow of State's internal coordination and approval process for completion of compliance checklist
- Enable an authorized user to notify differences to ICAO

Preformatted word document



☐ The feature is available only to NCMCs

- ✓ Once the word document is downloaded, data in the EFOD system is locked
- ✓ In order to allow users to edit data online, NCNC should either upload the word document or unlock the data

 - Update implementation status of PQ(S/NS/NA) with evidence
 - Provide implementation status of new questions
 - Attach evidence documents

- ✓ Keep Protocol Questions updated
- ✓ Update status of State's PQ based on latest CMA activities
- ✓ Generate the State LEI
- ✓ Collect information from external stakeholders

Mandatory Information Request (MIR)



ICAO

- ✓ Request States to submit specific information and documentation
- ✓ Include the following information when issuing MIRs
 - Relevant PQ(s)
 - Reason and reference for requesting information
 - Due date for requested information
- ✓ Record the result of review on submitted information and update the status of MIR (Closed/Open/escalated to Findings/SSC)


Mandatory Information Request (MIR)



☐ States

- ✓ Request extension of the due date
- ✓ Respond with evidence requested
- √ Supply requested information and/or documentation

Note: From 1 Jan 2013, email will serve as a main tool for ICAO to issue MIR until the online application is in place





☐ States

- ✓ View and search Findings by Area, CEs, PQ number
- ✓ Provide comments to ICAO on the **preliminary findings**



Findings & Recommendations (F&R)



☐ ICAO

- ✓ Update the status of existing F&R(s)
 - F&R(s) can only be closed when a CAP addresses all relevant PQs and it is fully implemented and validated
 - When all relevant PQs of a F&R are validated as satisfactory, then the LEI will be updated accordingly
- ✓ Issue new Finding(s) including:
 - A PQ and applicable CE found be to not-satisfactory;
 (With one finding addressing only one PQ)
 - A description of the identified deficiency

✓ Escalate the Finding(s) to an SSC






CAP in iSTARS

- ✓ Published according to predetermined timelines after the closing meeting of an onsite activity







Update on EFOD

Alternative means



- March 2011, Council agreed to use EFOD as an alternative means of filing of differences
- ☐ Jan 2011, CC data from 153 States were migrated into the EFOD system


Verification by States



- ☐ In April 2011, States were requested to: (SL AN 1/1-11/28)
 - ✓ Recognize EFOD as an alternative means of filing of differences
 - ✓ Verify and confirm the data in EFOD which had previously been submitted through CC under USOAP.
 - Over 100 States have been updating data in EFOD
 - 45 States sent replies (34 States completed verification, 11 States submitted plan for completion)

Background



□ Not proper functioning of the two requirements regarding differences from ICAO provisions

✓ According to USOAP report, more than 70% audited States were found to be not satisfactory in fulfilling requirements of filing and publication of differences.


