# BACKGROUND AND CONTEXT WHY AFI-PLAN?

#### Number of aircraft accidents in Africa

A review of the ICAO Accident/Incident Data Reporting (ADREP) data for a ten-year period, from 1997 to 2006, shows that there was an increase in the number of accidents in the AFI Region.

#### Safety oversight deficiencies

- lack of effective safety oversight systems;
- □ lack of expertise;
- ☐ Issues regarding air operator certificates (AOCs);
- □ lack of autonomous civil aviation authorities.

The Comprehensive Regional Implementation Plan for Aviation Safety in Africa (AFI Plan) was adopted by the 36th ICAO Assembly (Assembly Resolution A36-1).



## Objectives of the AFI Plan

- To strengthen civil aviation authorities with respect to their safety oversight capabilities;
- To increase compliance with ICAO SARPs and industry's best practices;
- To increase the number of qualified personnel at the industry and oversight levels;
- To improve the quality of inspectors and other civil aviation staff through training;



## AFI PLAN IMPLEMENTATION

- The work programme is developed around <u>three</u> focus areas to give effect to the objectives of the AFI Plan:
  - Enabling States to establish and maintain a sustainable safety oversight system;
  - Assisting States to resolve identified deficiencies within a reasonable time; and
  - 3. Enhancing aviation safety culture of African aviation service providers.


- Direct assistance to States to resolve identified deficiencies as detailed in the ICAO Plans of Action

- Develop & Implement Plans of Action to address deficiencies & attain the High-Level Safety Targets of the Abuja Ministerial Conference.
- Intensify ROSTs Activities in all areas other than Operations and Airworthiness (AGA,ANS, AIG)
- Design capacity building projects for sustainability
- Improve Effective Implementation (EI) by States

# Association of Africa Aviation Training Organizations (AATO)

#### Harmonization and standardization of Training

- Special AFI RAN Recommendation 5/8 Training Strategies for safety in Africa
- The AFI Plan promoted the establishment of AATO
- Constitutive Assembly of AATO held in Abuja (Nigeria) from 12th to 14th April, 2013
- Support AATO to be hosted in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia
- AATO already begun its operation from its headquarter at Addis Ababa Ethiopia



# ICAO PLANS OF ACTION (32 Plans of action signed 2011-2015)

# Immediate Term:

- Address the major safety deficiencies
- Regional Office Safety Teams (ROSTs) and/or AFCAC Cooperative Inspectorate Scheme (AFI-CIS)

## Near Term

- Continuation of the implementation of the State's Corrective Action Plan (CAP) to address the remaining deficiencies
- Mostly AFI-CIS

## Long Term

- Continue to monitor the situation on an on-going basis to promote aviation safety
- Ensure that the State maintains its ability to comply with safety oversight requirements, mainly through SSP implementation




#### 2016 AFI Plan Goals and Activities

- 70% of African States to achieve 60% EI and above
- No Significant Safety Concerns
- Certification of 45% of International Airports
- Full implementation of Work programme (All scheduled training and other activities)






#### Progress so far achieved on Safety Targets - AFI SSCs








#### Overall El by State



- ❖ 24 out of 52 Countries have achieved the overall El of 60% or more on 30<sup>th</sup> April 2016. That represents about 46% of African States
- \* The Average Overall El for AFRICA is 48,24%
- The Average Overall El for the World is 63,12%



AGA EI by State




- The Average EI of AGA for AFRICA is 41,37%

ANS EI by State




- The Average EI of ANS for AFRICA is 43,29%

- The Average El of AlG for the World is 54,41%








CE4 EI by State

AFRICA AFI




- The Average EI of CE4 for AFRICA is 36,83%
