Birth of the Collaborative Implementation Programme (CIP)

- **1st AFI Aviation Safety Symposium, Dakar, Senegal, 27 - 28 May 2014:**
 - *Discussed status of aviation safety and air navigation performance in the AFI Region;*
 - *Reviewed:*
 - ✓ *progress in attainment of regional aviation safety targets; and*
 - ✓ *Regional performance objectives for air navigation systems.*
- **CIP:**
 - *presented to and considered by AFI Plan SC/13 meeting, 29-30 May 2014.*
 - *integrated into AFI Plan work programme and presented to AFI Plan SC/14 meeting, Oct 2014.*



Collaborative Implementation – Initiatives with Partners

- ***Support to the Improvement of Aviation Safety in Africa (SIASA)- EU fund***
 - *Assistance missions to States,*
 - *Development of Regulations and guidance materials,*
 - *Conducting Workshops and Training:*
 - ✓ *SOFIA*
 - ✓ *ECCAIRS etc.*
- ***United States Technical Assistance***
 - *Seminars/Workshops/Training on strategies for managing effective ATM oversight organization.*
- ***IATA - Operational Safety Audit (IOSA)***
 - *Assist Airlines prepare for the IOSA Audits (Ref Abuja target)*
 - *Support in the establishment of the AOC database*



Collaborative Implementation – Initiatives with Partners

- ***AFCAC - AFI Cooperative Inspectorate Scheme (AFI-CIS)***
 - *Assist States resolve safety oversight deficiencies - priorities on:*
 - ✓ *the resolution of Significant Safety Concerns (SSCs), and*
 - ✓ *improvement of Effective Implementation (EI) of ICAO SARPs.*

- ***AFPP - Enhanced implementation of PBN***



Collaborative Implementation –Initiatives with Partners

- ***Regional Aviation Safety Group for the AFI region (RASG-AFI)***
 - *Support States in the establishment of Runway Safety Teams at International Airports;*
 - *Detailed Implementation Plans for Loss of Control in Flight (LOC-I) toolkit;*
 - *Development of Projects for Accident Investigation and Fundamentals of Safety Oversight; and*
 - *Extension to Aeronautical Information Management as an ESI.*



CIP Implementation Progress /Results

- *RASG –AFI Runway Safety Go-teams established at various airports;*
- *Two States(Zambia and Malawi) supported in the development of Regulations and manuals;*
- *Many seminars/workshops and training related to aviation safety provided;*
- *ICAO ROST assistance missions conducted in States;*
- *Support provided to many African states through AFI- CIS; and*
- *More than 15 African Airlines assisted to prepare for IOSA.*



CIP Implementation Challenges

- *Duplication of efforts in some programmes and projects;*
- *Establishment of clear time-bound common targets and priorities;*
- *Proper coordination of activities and work programmes.*
- *Etc.....*



Recommendations on CIP Implementation Improvement

- *Establish common set of priorities and goals,*
- *Popularize annual goals,*
- *Devise strategy that values strengths of individual partners,*
- *Mutual exchange/sharing of information on activities,*
- *Assistance through specific results based activities.*
- *Extend NCLB to all ICAO Strategic Objectives, and*
- *Anchor on new ICAO initiative for Building Global Partnership for Aviation Development (GPADs).*
