1. Venue and dates of the Workshop and Course

The Aeronautical Data Origination for Instrument Flight Design workshop will be held from 16 to 18 November 2016 at ICAO Regional Office for Western and Central Africa (WACAF) in Dakar, Senegal.

The PANS-OPS PBN Flight Procedure Design Course will be held at the African Flight Procedure Programme (AFPP) Office, Dakar, Senegal from 21 November to 16 December 2016.

The AFPP Office is located in Les Almadies, near The Leopold Sedar Senghor International Airport.

2. Languages

The Workshop and the course will be conducted in English.

3. Opening Session

The opening session of the workshop and the course will take place on Wednesday 16 November 2016 at 09:00 hours.

4. Registration

The registration of participants will take place at the site of the workshop on Wednesday 16 November 2016 from 08:30 to 09:00 hours and site of the course on Monday 21 November 2016 from 08:30 to 09:00 hours.

5. Documentation

The course will be paperless, all related documentation will be on line at www.icao.int/wacaf/african-fpp and participants are advised to bring laptops for access.

6. Weather and Clothing

The average temperature in Dakar is around 28°C. The weather could be subject to rain showers.

7. Procedures for obtaining an entry visa for Senegal

Senegalese visas are obtainable at Senegal Embassies, diplomatic missions and foreign offices or on arrival at Leopold Sédar Senghor International Airport. Delegates from States without Senegalese foreign missions are required to send passport to the ICAO WACAF regional office to facilitate application for Entry Visa on arrival at the Leopold Sédar Senghor International Airport in Dakar.

8. Health

Participants are advised that valid vaccination certificate against yellow fever is usually required in order to be granted entry into Senegal. Participants should also ensure that they have arranged for a valid health insurance for the coverage of any medical care during their stay in Senegal.

9. Banks and Currency

Banks are located not far from the course venue and are opened from 07:40 to 12:15 hours and 13:40 to 15:45 hours from Monday to Friday, and could be opened on Saturday morning. Local currency in CFA Franc (XOF) and the exchange rate is approximately 500 XOF for 1 USD, subject to fluctuation.

10. Hotels

A list of recommended hotels is attached hereto and **participants are required to make their own reservation** on line direct to the hotel of their choice from the list of the hotels attached.

Participants are informed that no transport service will be made available from the other hotels to the course place.
