2. Language

2.1. The workshop will be conducted in English.

3. Registration

3.1. The registration of participants will take place at the venue of the course on Tuesday 2 May 2023 from 08:00 to 08:30 hours UTC.

4. Opening Session

4.1. The opening session of the course will take place on Tuesday 2 May 2023 at 09:00 hours UTC.

5. Documentation

5.1. The workshop will be paperless and all related documentation will be online at https://www.icao.int/WACAF/Pages/PBNAwarenessWorkshop.aspx and www.icao.int/wacaf/african-fpp. Participants are advised to bring their laptops.

6. Weather and Clothing

6.1. The weather is warm and humid during this period in Accra and the average temperature is 34°C. The local time in Ghana is UTC.

7. Procedures for obtaining entry visa for Ghana

7.1. Ghanaian visas are obtainable at Ghana Embassies or consulates in their country. For participants from States without Ghanaian foreign missions, entry visa can be obtained on request upon arrival at the Accra Kotoko International Airport for a 150 USD fee.

8. Health

8.1. Participants are advised that valid vaccination certificate against yellow fever is usually required to be granted entry into Ghana. Participants should also ensure that they have arranged for a valid health insurance covering their stay in Ghana.

8.2. Covid-19 requirements

- 8.2.1.Except those coming from China, fully vaccinated travelers to Ghana are exempted from Covid-19 testing.
- 8.2.2.Passengers travelling from China, partially vaccinated or not vaccinated will be required to present a valid negative covid-19 PCR test result 48 hours prior to departure from the originating country. In addition, such passengers will be required to undergo mandatory covid-19 testing on arrival at the Kotoka International Airport at no cost.
- 8.2.3.In addition to the above, passengers may be randomly selected and offered test on arrival.
- 8.2.4.Participants may obtain COVID-19 testing for their return flights at the Airports Clinic Limited, at the Accra Kotoka International Airport.

9. Banks and Currency

9.1. Banks are located not far from the venue and are opened from 08:30 to 16:00 hours from Monday to Friday and could be opened on Saturday morning. Local currency in Ghana is New Cedi (GHS) and the exchange rate is approximately 12. 49 GHS for 1 USD, subject to fluctuation.

10. Hotels

- 10.1. A list of recommended hotels is attached hereto and participants are required to make their own reservation online or on phone to the hotel of their choice from the list of hotels.
- 10.2. Participants are informed that no transport service will be provided from the hotels to the venue.
