Subject: PBN Flight Procedure Design Training Course, Nairobi, Kenya.

Action required: Confirm participation not later than 29 April 2024.

Sir/Madam.

I have the honour to invite your Administration/Organization to the PBN Flight Procedure Design Course, organized by the African Flight Procedure Programme (AFPP) at the East African School of Aviation (EASA), Nairobi, Kenya, from 13 May to 6 June 2024.

The course aims to assist States and Air Navigation Service Providers in building capacities in the instrument flight procedures field. The course is the second step of thorough training in the design of IFR trajectories based on the PBN concept and criteria. In this course, PBN concept, related regulations and practical materials to perform the computation and the design of PBN flight procedures for all phases of flight will be discussed (Standard Instrument Departure (SIDs), Standard Instrument Arrival (STARs) and Non-Precision Approaches (NPA) including APV baro-VNAV.

Nominated candidates should include Air Navigation Subject Matter Experts and preferably Air Traffic Controllers, Air Navigation Engineers or pilots employed by a regulatory authority, or an authorized service provider, qualified to conduct instrument flight procedure designs. Current or former instrument flight procedure designers or Air Traffic Management experts involved in flight regulatory approval processes are also accepted. Candidates are expected to be senior experienced experts with adequate communication skills in the English language. However, to enable the completion of their training curriculum, priority will be given to trainees having already attended the last flight procedure design training course organized by the Programme in March 2024.

The course will be conducted in the English language. The draft agenda, the registration form, the information bulletin, and the list of suggested hotels are provided as attachments to the letter. Please note that the use of hard copy documentation at the course will be kept to a minimum. Participants are therefore encouraged to bring along suitable equipment and accessories such as laptops, scientific calculators, and USB keys to enable effective participation.

The course is free of charge for the active members of the African Flight Procedure Programme (AFPP) in good standing with regards to their annual contributions to the Programme. All other States interested in participating, will be considered, if possible, with a **4,000 USD** fee per participant. Your Administration/Organization is expected to fund the travel, accommodation and living expenses for the selected candidates.

Enrolment for the course is limited to 24 participants. You are therefore invited to nominate at your earliest convenience but not later than **29 April 2024**, a maximum of two qualified participants for this course, indicating their order of priority if more than one person is nominated. Resume of each candidate should be included as part of the registration to assist in the selection process.
