1. Introduction


- 1.1. As a recall, up to now, the Programme is executed based on the Programme Document signed by the Host Administration and ICAO and to which any State/Aviation organization wishing to participate shall sign on.
- 1.2. This paper provides the status of the membership in the Programme as well as the evolution in the membership. The list of the current active members is provided in Appendix 1 and status of the annual contributions in Appendix 2.

2. Discussion

- 2.1. At its creation in 2014, the scope of the Programme was extending to all African States, reason why the name was turned from AFI-FPP to African-FPP. Now that the MID FPP is launched, the question is to know if the name should still be African FPP or not.
- 2.2. As of 23 August 2022, the membership status is as shown below:

2.5. It should be noted that some of the active members are not paying their annual subscriptions. This led the seventh steering committee to take decision SC/7-Dec-14 requesting to demote the active members in arrears of more than three years as Users. The meeting has to define the reference year to consider for the arrears and therefore establish the list of active members to be demoted. The status of the annual contributions is provided in Appendix 2.
