2. Languages

The workshop will be conducted in English.

3. Opening Session

The opening session of the workshop will take place on Monday 9 November 2015 at 9:00 hours.

4. Registration

The registration of participants will take place at the site of the course on Monday 9 November 2015 from 08:30 to 09:00 hours.

5. Documentation

The workshop will be paperless and all related documentation will be on line at www.icao.int/WACAF/Pages/PANS-OPS.aspx and www.icao.int/wacaf/african-fpp and participants are advised to bring laptops for access.

6. Weather and Clothing

The average temperature in Dakar is around 28°C.

7. Procedures for obtaining an entry Visa for Senegal

Since 1st July 2015, entry Visa for Senegal is delivered free of charge. An application request for an entry Visa should be addressed to a Senegalese diplomatic representation, the nearest from your residence. The application for visas is no more possible on the dedicated website. Visas are not required for Nationals from Economic Community of West African States (ECOWAS) or other States applying the same regulation.

Participants who would have difficulties for issuing an entry Visa, would inform the meeting points of contact as soon as possible for assistance.

8. Health

Participants are advised that valid vaccination certificate against yellow fever is usually required in order to be granted entry into Senegal. Participants should also ensure that they have arranged for a valid health insurance for the coverage of any medical care during their stay in Senegal.

9. Banks and Currency

Banks are located not far from the course venue and are opened from 07:45 to 12:15 hours and 13:45 to 15:45 hours from Monday to Friday, and could be opened on Saturday morning. Local currency in CFA Franc (XOF) and the exchange rate is approximately 575 XOF for 1 USD, subject to fluctuation.

10. Hotels

A list of recommended hotels is attached hereto and **participants are required to make their own reservation** on line direct to the hotel of their choice from the list of the hotels provided.

11. Transportation

Participants are informed that no transport service will be made available from the hotels to the course place.
