


Figure 1. Participants au développement d'une IFP

Initiation in Process






Figure 3. Processus de développement d'une IFP



Initiation



- Formalize the request for new or modified FPD
- Provide rationales, plan
- Who?
 - State (strategical plan)
 - Operators (improve operations: safety, cost, etc.)
 - Airport (improve ATM, capacity, etc.)
 - Environment
 - Etc.
- Inform all stakeholders
- Go / No Go?

Remove Circle to land

Improve Minima

Optimize noise impact

Fully guided trajectories

Increase airport capacity

Reduce fuel consumption

Role of State in the Initiation phase



- Each State should describe the initiation and submission process valid within their State.
- Agree on Planning
- Present existing regulation and specificities
- Assign Project manager and organisation responsibilities
- Identify parallel tasks



Document



Conclusion of the initiation phase should be formalized:

- In documentation maintained by the state
- If IFP is to be developed:
 - Project manager nominated; one focal point per stakeholder
 - Procedure designer identified
 - Contracts signed (if working with third party)
 - Scope is defined
