

Progress Implementation of ASTCs Activities

- Most ASTC have commendably developed and are implementing AVSEC Screeners Courses as preparatory training to certification/recertification of Screeners in compliance with National Civil Aviation Security Training Programmes of their respective Countries.
- In addition, it is worthy to note, that Dangerous Goods trainings has been developed by most ASTCs to assist the States in training of Screeners/Cargo handlers.

Progress On Implementation of ASTCs Activities

- Available statistics indicate that majority of the ASTCs in the regions were engaged in conducting trainings. (1790 personnel trained)
- Coordination and collaborations within the ASTCs is commendable.
- Most ASTCs have their training schedules advertised on their website.

Challenges

- Low recovery process from Covid-19 travel restrictions
- Reduced fund allocation for trainings by member states.
- ASTC, Johannesburg (SA) is heavily affected by Covid-19 related challenges, hence yet to record any activity.

Recommendations

 Regular deliberations in coordinated meeting of ASTCs Coordinators/Directors in the regions including staffers is recommended.

 Need for greater interaction and exchange programmes between AFI -ASTCs to share their practices and experiences.

Recommendations

- The need to bring in all ASTCs into a community platform or Forum for deliberations and discussions should be considered.
- ICAO could where necessary increase the number of sponsored courses in each ASTC from one (1) to two (2) or more.

Conclusion

- The ASTCs in Africa have continued to make giant strides in the face of Covid-19 related limitations and dwindling resources.
- Africa ASTCs have made good efforts towards the development and implementation of more relevant courses and programmes to help the industry mitigate new and emerging security threats.
- We are confident that the Johannesburg ASTC would very soon surmount the current challenges and continue to support the Human Resource Development needs of the industry.
