Subject: **Second Meeting of the CAFSAT management Committee CNMC/2, (Dakar, Senegal 06-08 November 2012).**

Action Required: Reply not later than 04 October 2012.

Sir/Madam,

I have the honor to draw your attention and invite your Administration/Organization to the Second Meeting of the CAFSAT Network Management Committee (CNMC/2), that will be held in the conference room of the ICAO Regional Office for Western and Central Africa (WACAF), Dakar, Senegal, from 6 to 8 November 2012.

As its provisional Agenda hereto attached indicates, the CNMC/2 Meeting will, among other things, mainly review the status of implementation of the conclusions and decisions of the CNMC/1 meeting held in Recife, Brazil on 2 May 2011, analyze the performance of CAFSAT earth stations and the operational statistics of availability for supported links; the meeting will also examine the actions conducted for the interconnection of CAFSAT with its neighboring Networks, discuss the status of implementation of conclusion 6/19 of the Special AFI/RAN meeting that calls for regular meetings of all AFI network managers, review the progress made for the modernization and re-engineering of the CAFSAT Network, address the Final Acts of ITU WRC-12 pertaining to a proper operation of aeronautical VSATs networks in the 3400-4200 MHz C-Band, and update the Terms of Reference and Work programme of the Committee as adopted by the SAT/15 meeting.

In this regard, the attention of your Administration/Organization is being drawn to the need to participate actively by preparing Working Papers and providing the necessary inputs in relation to the individual Agenda items of the above meeting.

Taking into consideration paragraphs 2 and 3 of the CNMC Terms of Reference, Observers such as facilities providers, satellite spectrum providers, Air Navigation Service Providers and Airline Associations have been invited to give information on current technologies and their future development.

You will also find attached the General information bulletin with the list of Hotels in Dakar. Meanwhile, be advised that Working Papers prepared by the Secretariat will be available on the websites of ICAO WACAF and SAM Offices and those forwarded by the Administrations/Organizations will be posted as soon as they are received.
