



COURSE DESCRIPTION

OBJECTIVES

Generically know the Aeronautical infra-structures, facilities, services and Aeronautical organizations that have a direct relationship with the normal performance of the AIS and COM services, namely, their organization, objectives, functions and applicable general regulation.
