

The app shows financial flows by donor State The data is from OECD public database and ICAO information It can serve as an advocacy document that recipient States can use to promote the financial support received from donors





Recipient States ranked on the amount of ODA in USD effectively disbursed and committed for future years







Analysis

According to OECD data, in 2015, Belgium provided around USD 2.2 billion in ODA and USD 1.6 billion in private flows at market terms. During the ten-year-period 2005-2015, Belgium's economic situation induced variations in the amount of private flows at market terms while ODA remained stable.

Belgium is the 10th largest donor in terms of ODA as per cent of GNI and the 15th largest donor in terms of total ODA volume. In fact, Belgium provided USD 1.89 billion in net ODA in 2015. This represents 0.42% of the country's GNI which is 0.28% below the 0.7% target set by the Pearson Commission in 1969 and adopted by the UN.

Belgium's ODA flows are primarily focused on the Southern Sahara region and amounted on average, between 2014 and 2015, to 36% of the ODA by region. During the same period, Belgium committed to allocate 8.4% of its ODA to the economic infrastructure sector. In 2015, the country donated more than USD 102 million to the sector, USD 0.07 million of which were given to air transport representing 0.07% of the ODA to economic infrastructure and services.
