
CODEVMET – AFI SC/1 Report

1. Introduction

- 1.1. The first Steering Committee meeting (SC/01) of the Cooperative Development of Aeronautical Meteorology services in the AFI region (CODEVMET AFI) was held from 7 to 8 February 2018 in the ICAO Western and Central African Regional Office (WACAF), Dakar premises.
- 1.2. That meeting placed the emphasis on a rapid operationalization of the CODEVMET Programme in order to address long outstanding deficiencies in the Aeronautical Methodology in a cooperative approach, based on the review of the achievements and lessons learned from the implementation of the predecessor of the Project.
- 1.3. The meeting came up with 11 decisions aiming at continuously improving the effectiveness of CODEVMET project in the framework of enhancement of State MET Safety oversight system and helping MET services Providers to comply with ICAO SARPs.

2. Discussion

2.1. The status of the SC/1 Decisions was reviewed on 25 July 2021. The graphic below provides an overview of the implementation of the SC/1 decisions as 25 July 2018 and as of 5 July 2021.
