Launching meeting

- Purpose: Sensitize States on the objectives of the activities and get the CEOs commitment
- Date and venue: 2020 and 2022 in Freetown and Abuja
- Participants: Regional Office and the beneficiary States



Familiarization workshop

- Purpose
 - Familiarize participants with procedures and tools implemented by States that have already certified an airport
 - Provide guidance on the project implementation activities
- Date and venue
 - From 4 to 8 July, Hybrid (online and onsite (Nigeria and Sierra Leone))
- Participants: Experts and technical personnel from beneficiary and donor States and Organizations (BAGASOO, URSAC)

Submission of the action plans

- Purpose: Develop for each State a comprehensive programme and plan for the certification of its designated aerodromes.
- Components of the action plan:
 - CAA: organization (establishment), regulations, procedures and tools
 - Operator: organisation, aerodrome manual, procedures, documentation et maps. Action plan related to the implementation of the APEX review recommendations and any other assessment
- Deadline: 15 July 2022
- Responsibles: Beneficiary States

Implementation monitoring mechanism

- Purpose: Ensure the effective implementation of agreed action plans and certification activities
- Activities:
 - Assign to each State, Experts for the monitoring purpose
 - Remotely monitoring by Experts of the implementation of the action plans
 - States to forward to ICAO, monthly reports of the implementation of action plans
- **Duration**: 5 months
- Responsibles: Beneficiary States, ICAO Regional Office, Project Team

Preparation for certification (optional)

- Purpose: Review the implementation of action plans and assist States as may be required
- Activities:
 - On site review by an Expert of progress made
 - Review of the operator activities including aerodrome visit
 - Preparation for the certification audit
- Duration: 3 days per State/airport
- Responsibles: Beneficiary States and Project Team

Conduct of certification audits

- Purpose: Assist States in the conduct of certification audits
- Activities:
 - On site mission of one or more Experts of the Project team
 - Assistance in the conduct of the certification audit
- Duration: 15 days per airport
- Responsibles: Beneficiary States and Project Team

Review of the certification process

- Purpose: Wrap up of the whole certification process to ensure its compliance with SARPs
- Activities: On site mission of the ICAO RO-AGA in each State
- Duration: 5 days per State
- Responsibles: Beneficiary States and ICAO

The Project Team

Composition of the Project Team:

- ICAO Regional Office
- 4 Experts (tasked by ICAO) from States that has certified at least one aerodrome (Ghana and Côte d'Ivoire). 2 from CAAs and 2 from aerodrome Operators
- Experts from BAGASOO and URSAC
- Etc.

Beneficiary States personnel

Qualifications/experience criteria: Qualification in one of the aerodromes technical areas (civil engineering, electrical engineering, firefighting services, SMS, wildlife hazard management, aerodrome operations)

- Focal point focal of the CAA: Aerodrome inspector
- Focal point of the aerodrome operator for the certification
