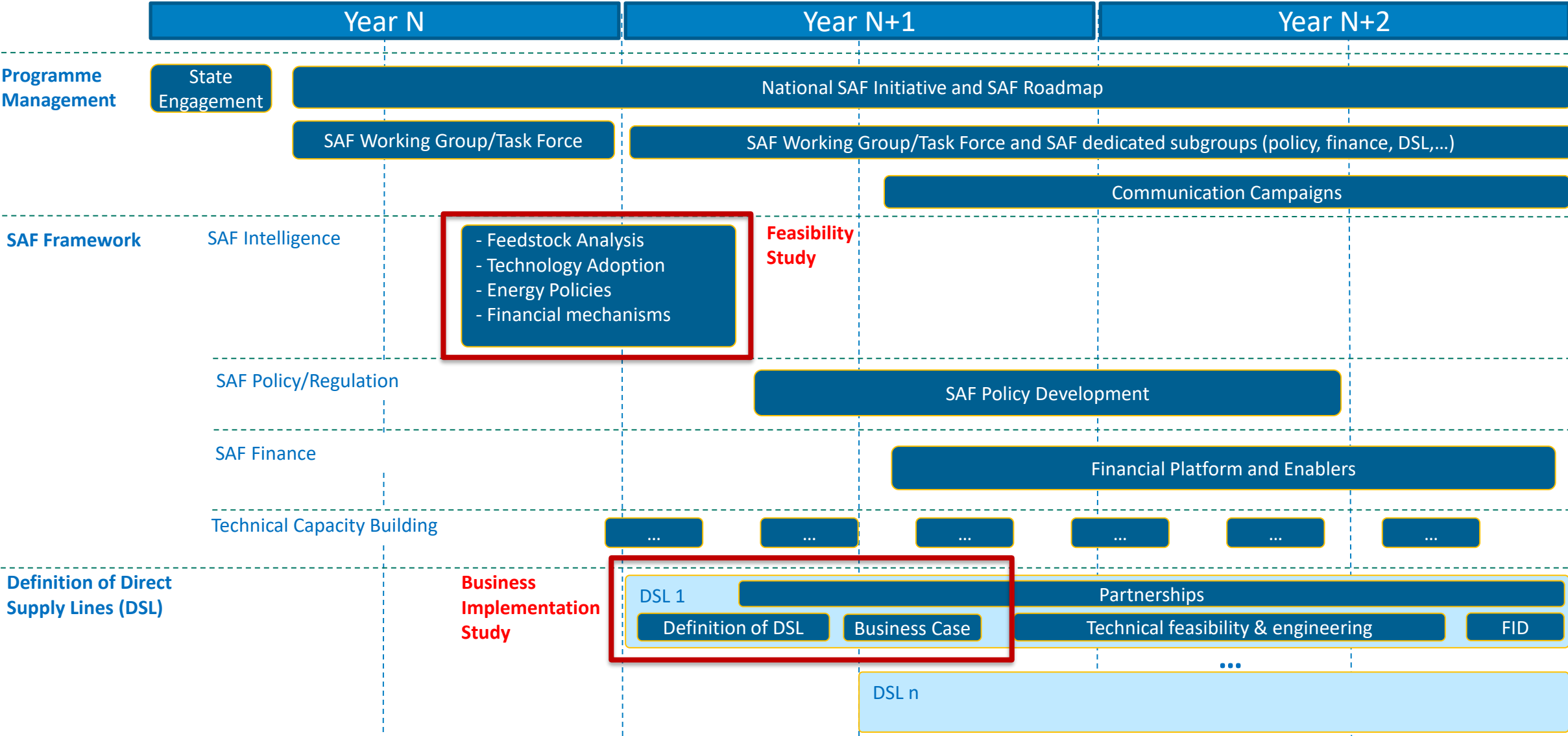

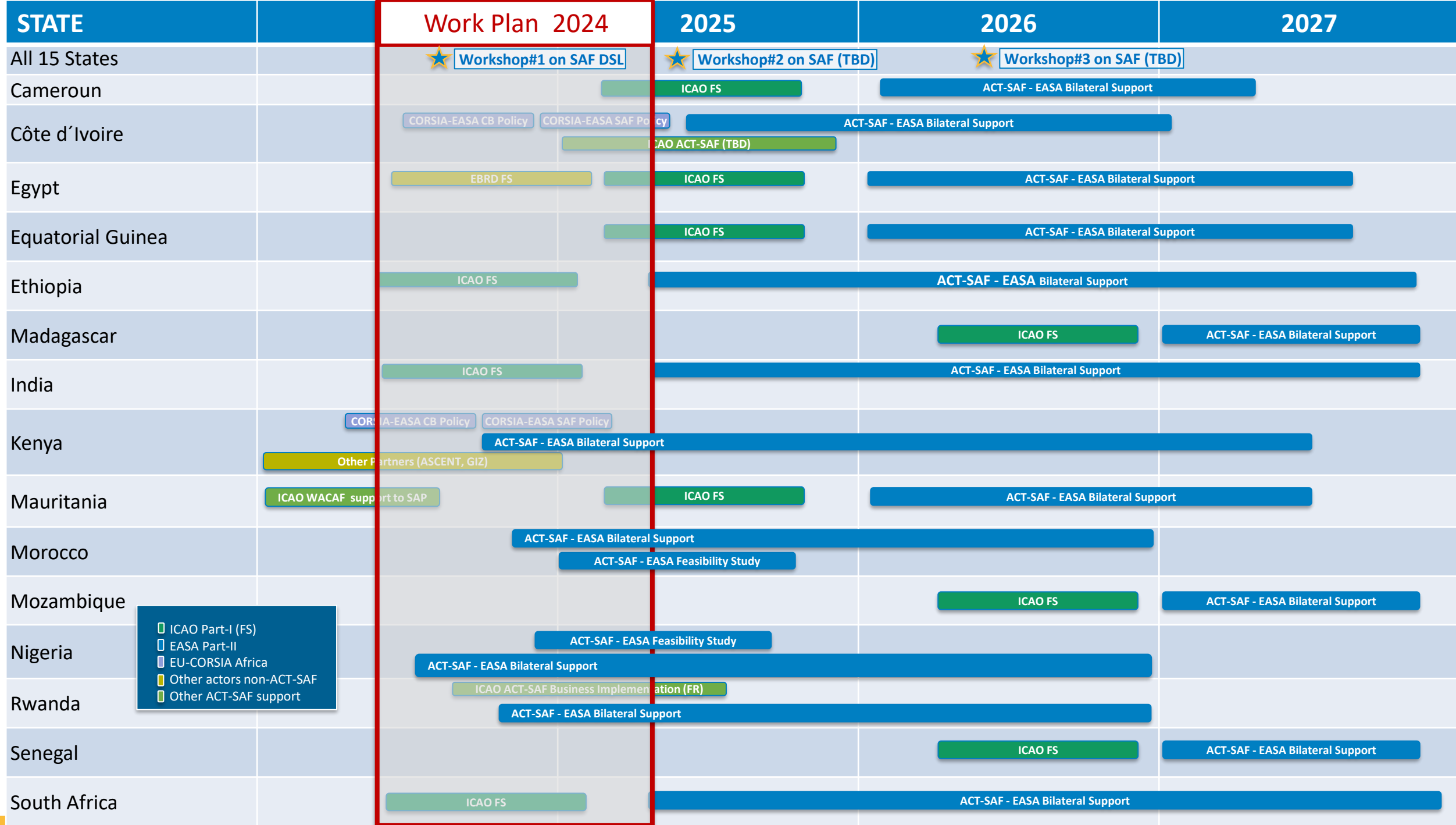
Project Overview

- **EU Contribution to ICAO ACT-SAF Initiative**
- Timelines: February 2024 – December 2027
- **Staggered Implementation** to support the 14 States in Africa and India, maximising synergies and outputs
- Project with two implementing partners:
 - **Part I - ICAO** providing 10 Feasibility/Business Implementation Studies for 9 African States, plus India
 - **Part II - EASA** providing wider range of support to facilitate actioning of SAF production in 14 African States, plus India
 - Implementation of **Work Plan 2024/25 coordinated** with supported States and with other supporting Partners (e.g., NL, Airbus, ASCENT Project 93)

Work accomplished



- Map out of SAF preparedness for all States – SAF Country Profiles
- Staggered implementation in synch between ICAO and EASA
- Onboarding of all States, including discussion on Work Plan with first group of countries (Nigeria, Kenya, Rwanda, Morocco)
- 1st ACT-SAF Workshop for Africa – 30.09/02.10 Mombasa (Kenya) – EU/EASA organised, coordinated with ICAO, ASCEND, GIZ
 - Over 230 participants, 14 African States, 90 organisations/governmental departments
 - Discussion of 3 African SAF Productions Projects
 - 2 in Côte d'Ivoire – AtJ and Coprocessing,
 - 1 in Kenya – HEFA
 - Positive signals from WB, EBRD, SMBC, Freshfields
 - Field trip to Mombasa Refinery
- 2nd Kenya National SAF Committee – 03/04.10 Mombasa (Kenya)
 - Over 70 people, 30 stakeholders engaged
 - Launch of 6 Technical Working Groups
 - 1 SAF Production project (HEFA) under assessment

 - Feasibility Study in 2025
- Kenya
 - Support to National SAF Committee
 - Technical contribution to Technical Working Groups (e.g. SAF Roadmap, Financial Model, Refinery repurposing)
- Rwanda
 - Support to develop SAF Roadmap (proposal)
- Morocco
 - Support to State SAF Programme and SAF Roamap (proposed)
- 2nd ACT-SAF Workshop for Africa
- Discussion of Work Plan 2025-2026
- Continuing coordination with States and supporting Partners

Work ahead Q3-Q4 2025-2027 (tentative)



- 2025: India, South Africa, Ethiopia
- 2026: Egypt, Cameroon, Equatorial Guinea, Mauritania
- 2027: Madagascar, Mozambique, Senegal
