Introduction

- The Procedure for the Amendment of the Regional Air Navigation Plans, as approved by Council on 18 June 2014, is provided in Appendix A of the Volume I of the AFI eANP.
- The Assembly has resolved that regional plans should be revised when it becomes apparent that they are no longer consistent with current and foreseen requirements of international civil aviation.
- When the nature of a required change permits, the associated amendment of the regional plan should be undertaken by means of correspondence between the Organization and the States and international organizations concerned.
- When a State cannot immediately implement a particular part or a specific detail of the regional plan although it intends to do so, when practicable, this should not lead to the State proposing an amendment to the plan.



Inter Volumes consistency of PfA

- The general structure of the regional plans for the parts which concern an air navigation field in Volumes I and II consists of an "Introduction", "General Regional Requirements" and "Specific Regional Requirements".
- As the section "General Regional Requirements" is harmonized for all regions, an amendment of the provisions (text) in "General Regional Requirements" will lead to amendment of Volumes I and II of the regional plans of all regions.



Inter Volumes consistency of PfA

- When proposing an amendment to the eANP, the consistency of tables content should be observed across Volume I and Volume II.
- State to ensure consistency between TABLE AOP I-1 and Table AOP II-1.

Inter Areas consistency of PfA

- The proposal for amendment will be made by the States/organizations in AOP, ATM, SAR, CNS, AIM and MET areas.
- It is important to keep in mind that an amendment made in one area by a State, may affect other areas and even other States within the same volume.
- For instance, if a **State A**, through its proposal for amendments (PfA) remove aerodrome(s) from *Table AOP I-1 on the International Aerodromes required in The AFI Region*, that may have **an impact** in ATM, CNS, AIM, MET and SAR areas of the State. In addition, the **other States** should also be informed of this significant amendment which may require actions from them.



Inter Areas consistency of PfA

- When proposing an amendment to the Volume II of the eANP, the consistency of tables content should be observed across all the areas: AOP, CNS, ATM, SAR, MET and AIM.
- Ensure consistency between TABLE AOP II-1 and Tables CNS II-4, CNS II-AFI-1.
