Ambassador Michel Arslanian Neto was appointed Representative of Brazil on the ICAO Council on 26 June 2023.

After joining the Brazilian Ministry of Foreign Affairs in 1994, Mr. Arslanian held a number of positions including: Assistant at the MERCOSUR Division (1994-1998); Deputy head of the Services, Investment and Financial Affairs Division (2004-2008); Advisor to the Office of the Minister of Foreign Affairs (2011-2013); General coordinator of political and economic planning at the Secretariat for Diplomatic Planning (2013-2016); Director of the Department of Regional Economic Integration (2016-2019); Director of the Department of MERCOSUR and Regional Integration (2019-April 2022); Director of the MERCOSUR Department (April 2022-July 2022); and Secretary of the Americas (July 2022- March 2023).

Mr. Arslanina's overseas postings include the Brazilian Mission to the European Union (1998-2001) in Brussels; the Permanent Delegation to the Latin American Integration Association and MERCOSUR (2001-2004) in Montevideo; and the Brazilian Mission to the Organization of American States (2008-2011) in Washington DC. In 2016, he served at the Embassy of Brazil in Yaoundé on a temporary basis.

Ambassador Michel Arslanian Neto holds a degree in Economics from the Federal University of Rio de Janeiro. In 1998, he completed a specialization course on European Integration at the Collège d'Europe, in Bruges.
