#### ADDITION OF US NON AOP OPMET DATA AND THE PROVISION OF REMARKS AS PART OF THE METAR

(Presented by the WIFS Provider State)

#### SUMMARY

This paper informs the MOG of the planned addition of 218 non-AOP US METAR/TAF sites to the international US collectives and the establishment of new WMO collectives. The paper also proposes that 47 non-AOP airports be removed from Annex 2 MET Table 2A. The paper also reminds the group in the change of US policy that all US AOP and non-AOP METAR/SPECIs will include remarks at the end of the report.

## 1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 The Washington OPMET data bank provides Operational Meteorological (OPMET) data in support of domestic (i.e., the United States [US]) and international (i.e., ICAO) requirements and obligations.

1.2 The US received a request from the International Air Transport Association (IATA) to add additional US Non-Aerodrome Operational Planning (Non-AOP) airports for global distribution on the World Area Forecast System File Service (WIFS). This request was reviewed and accepted by the US Meteorological (MET) Authority, which is the US Federal Aviation Administration (FAA).

<sup>1</sup> The terms 'AOP' and 'non-AOP' are used in this paper to refer to aerodromes that are either listed or not listed in the Tables AOP in the regional air navigation plans. Note: in accordance with the regional air navigation plans, the 'AOP' aerodromes also appear in Table MET II-2 – *Aerodrome Meteorological Offices*, which names the aerodromes where meteorological service is required. Consequently, there is no regional air navigation agreement for States to provide OPMET data from 'non-AOP' aerodromes, but in many cases this is done on a voluntary basis.

1.3 In addition, the group should recall that the US has changed its policy on the inclusion of Remarks as part of the METAR for global dissemination. This change in policy was announced at the First Meeting of MOG (8-11 September 2015 in Gatwick)

1.4 The primary purpose of the paper is to advise the MOG on the planned changes for international distribution of AOP and non-AOP airports from the United States to satisfy the operational requirements provided to the US from IATA for Traditional Alphanumeric Codes (TAC).

## 2. DISCUSSION

2.1 In light of the increasing use of Non-AOP aerodromes by international operators the United States will add 218 Non-AOP METAR and TAF sites to the U.S. international collectives. Attachment A to this paper provides the list of non-AOP airports to be added.

2.2 There are two challenges on how to provide this information. One pertains to updating the existing MET Table 2A of the SADIS User Guide (SUG) which is the reference source for global dissemination of METAR/TAF airports via the World Area Forecast System File Service (WIFS) and the Secured Aviation Digital Information Service (SADIS). The second challenge is to coordinate this change with other Regional OPMET Centers where there is an agreement to exchange US METAR/TAF reports.

2.3 The current U.S. aerodromes listed in SUG Annex1 have 78 AOP and 428 non-AOP airports. The US will be adding 218 non-AOP airports to the list in MET Table 2A of SUG. The U.S. will be recommending to SADIS the removal of some 46 airports where there is no longer a validated requirement to provide a METAR/TAF report for international operations. This list of airports is provided in Attachment B. Before the U.S. removes these airports the U.S. will validate this with IATA. In total the revised validated listing of US AOP and non-AOP airports where IATA has a service request for METAR/TAF reports will be 678.

2.4 The new list of 678 stations will use the following WMO series FT/SA/SPUS21-25 KWBC. The current list of 418 AOP and non-AOP airports under the WMO series FT/SA/SPUS71-75 KWBC will be retired. The US is in the process of updating ICAO DOC 7910 (Station Identifiers) to ensure that any new U.S. non-AOP aerodromes are properly recorded in ICAO Doc 7910.

2.5 However, as noted in attachment A there are 37 non-AOP airports that are not ICAO Doc 7910, but require METAR/TAF reports. These airports are identified by being highlighted in yellow. The US will undertake an action to coordinate the inclusion of these airports in ICAO Doc 7910. There is a note in SADIS TABLE MET II-2 - AERODROME METEOROLOGICAL OFFICES EXPLANATION OF THE TABLE that the States need to notify ICAO of the airport LOCID to be used for the purpose of exchanging reports.

2.6 The US has taken a position that the Washington OPMET Databank will use the same collectives for exchange of information with other Regional OPMET Centers where an exchange policy or agreement exists. This same collective will be coordinated with the SADIS Provider State for distribution on SADIS. Therefore, the collectives on WIFS and SADIS for US airports will be identical.

2.7 The meeting should note as previously advised that the IATA requirement for the additional non-AOP airports and the requirement to include Remarks the US will be accommodated with the new WMO headers as identified in paragraph 2.1.4 above.

2.8 Users of U.S. METAR reports are encouraged to access the following link below to retrieve the United States Federal Meteorological Handbook (FMH-1) Surface Observations that documents the METAR code format with Remarks.

### **3.0 CONCLUSION**

3.1 The meeting is to take note in the change in US policy to meet operational requirements from IATA to:

- a. Provide Remarks for U.S. METAR globally for both AOP and non-AOP airports
- b. Update the global distribution of METAR/TAF reports from the U.S. to meet IATA's requirement for flight planning.

3.2 The meeting is to take note of the change in WMO Headers for the provision of the new collectives with Remarks from the U.S.

3.3 The US will provide an implementation date via a NWS Technical Information Notice and will coordinate that information with the SADIS manager and rapporteur for MOG as well with other ROC as required.

3.4 The US will work with the SADIS managers on how best to document non-AOP airports from the US and to resolve any inconsistency of the information provided.

3.5 The US will update ICAO Doc 7910 accordingly to ensure that all aerodromes where MET information is provided have a LOCID listed in the reference document. The updates will occur in accordance with ICAO practices.

### **4. ACTION BY THE MEETING \***

4.1 The meeting is invited to:

- a. Note that the US plans to add 218 aerodromes to the existing list of 428 aerodromes (as listed in SUG Annex 1/FASID Table MET 2A) where the US is required to issue OPMET information (METAR/SPECI, TAF) for availability in SADIS and WIFS in addition to the 78 aerodromes in the US where meteorological service is required in accordance with the provisions of Annex 3 and regional air navigation plans.;
- b. Note that the US plans to cease the issuance of OPMET information (METAR/SPECI, TAF) for availability on SADIS and WIFS for 46 non-AOP aerodromes (currently listed in SUG Annex 1/FASID Table MET 2A), upon confirmation from IATA that there is no operational requirement for these 46 aerodromes;
- c. Note that the US plans to use the WMO abbreviated headings FT/SA/SPUS21-25 KWBC for OPMET issued by the US for international civil aviation and to retire the use of the WMO abbreviated headings FT/SA/SPUS71-75 KWBC;
- d. The US will work with the SADIS managers on how best to document non-AOP airports from the US and to resolve any inconsistency of the information provided and assess the requirements for consequential amendments as necessary, in view of a, b and c, above; and
- e. Note that the US plans to include additional information in OPMET data issued for global dissemination in the form of remarks appended to the METAR message, which is not compliant with the Annex 3 provisions for METAR/SPECI [Annex 3, Table A3-2].

\*The effective date for the changes in US OPMET issuance for a to d will be coordinated with ICAO APAC via electronic correspondence with a minimum lead time of no less than 75 days for implementation.
