I wish to inform you that a combined Workshop on Loss of Control in-Flight (LOC-I), Upset Prevention and Recovery Training (UPRT) and Operation of Aircraft (OPS) is planned to take place at the Mövenpick Hotel, Nairobi, Kenya, from 27 to 29 October 2025. This workshop is organized by the ICAO ESAF Regional Office with the support of the ICAO WACAF Regional Office and Kenya, as Champion.

The workshop which will be conducted in English only, will review mitigation measures on LOC-I in the AFI Region, assist in the implementation of the AFI 5-year LOC-I Plan and help enhance the safety enhancement initiatives for NASPs and AFI-RASP as per the ICAO GASP. It will also address common challenges related to Flight Data Monitoring, SMS, and performance-based SARPs.

A detailed programme will be shared in due course.

The target audience includes civil aviation inspectors in operations of aircraft, personnel licensing and safety from civil aviation administrations, aircraft incidents and accidents investigators from accidents investigation authorities and pilots, instructors and other operations personnel from air operators and training organizations.
