I am pleased to refer to the program of activities of the Regional Project RLA/06/901 and invite you to participate in the Thirty Fourth Workshop/Meeting of the South American Region Implementation Group (SAM/IG/34), which will be held at the ICAO offices in Lima, Peru from 24 to 28 August 2026.

This Workshop/Meeting aims to continue the technical activities linked to the implementation of the Regional Air Navigation Plan (RANP CAR/SAM), the Global Air Navigation Plan (GANP – Edition 8), as well as regional initiatives aimed at the modernization, interoperability, resilience and sustainability of ATM/CNS systems.

During this event, the deliverables and technical advances developed by GESEA and the GT Interop study groups will be presented, including activities related to regional interoperability, FF-ICE implementation, CNS resilience, ATM modernization and regional coordination for communications, navigation and surveillance. The development of the Regional Air Navigation Plan and the promotion of GREPECAS programs and projects will be addressed.

For a more detailed analysis of the matters to be discussed, the provisional Agenda with its explanatory notes and tentative Work Program (**Attachment A**) is included, which is considering that the Twenty First Meeting of the Coordination Committee (RCC/21) will be held on Thursday, August 27, 2026, in the afternoon.

Please note that the event will be held in Spanish and will have simultaneous interpretation into English. The profile of the participants and the objectives of the event are presented in the Mnemonic Note (**Attachment B**).

To guide the discussions of the Workshop/Meeting, States and Organizations should submit the working papers and Information papers referring to the agenda items. Working papers must be sent to this Regional Office in Spanish and English. The Information papers must be sent in the language(s) decided by the originator.

All documentation should be submitted no later than **July 24, 2026**, to be posted on the event website by **August 17th, 2026**. Papers submitted after the above deadlines may be included in the documentation for the subsequent SAM/IG Workshop/Meeting scheduled for 2027, subject to coordination with the Secretariat.
