I would like to refer to the report of the Twenty-Third Meeting of the Regional Planning and Implementation Group for the Caribbean and South America – GREPECAS/23, held in Mexico City, from 4 to 6 March 2026, in this regard, I wish to invite your Administration/Organization to participate in the First Joint Meeting of the Coordination of Air Traffic Management (ATM) of North America, the Caribbean and South America (NAM/CAR/SAM/ATM/1), which will be held at the ICAO South American (SAM) Regional Office, Lima, Peru, from 19 to 21 October 2026.
