## Objectives of the AFI Plan

The Comprehensive Regional Implementation Plan for Aviation Safety in Africa (AFI Plan) was adopted by the 36th ICAO Assembly (Assembly Resolution A36-1).

#### **Objectives:**

- To strengthen civil aviation authorities with respect to their safety oversight capabilities;
- To increase compliance with ICAO SARPs and industry's best practices;
- To increase the number of qualified personnel at the industry and oversight levels;
- To improve the quality of inspectors and other civil aviation staff through training.




## **AFI Plan Implementation**

#### **Focus Areas:**

- 1. Enable States to establish and maintain a sustainable safety oversight system;
- 2. Assist States to resolve identified deficiencies within a reasonable time;
- 3. Enhance aviation safety culture of African aviation service providers.



# **Establishment of the Association of Africa Aviation Training Organizations (AATO)**


- Harmonization and standardization of Aviation Training in Africa

# Establishing & Strengthening of Regional Safety Oversight Organizations (RSOOS) In Africa





### ICAO PLANS OF ACTION

(34 tailored Plans of action signed 2011-2017)

- Address the major safety deficiencies
- Regional Office Safety Teams (ROSTs) and/or AFCAC Cooperative Inspectorate Scheme (AFI-CIS)
- Continuation of the implementation of the State's Corrective
   Action Plan (CAP) to address the remaining deficiencies
- Continue to monitor the situation on an on-going basis to promote aviation safety
- Ensure that the State maintains its ability to comply with safety oversight requirements, mainly through SSP implementation




# **Establishment of Projects**



# Progress in the attainment of the Safety Targets - Resolution of SSCs



### Average Overall El Africa vs World





- 26 out of 52 Countries have achieved the overall El of 60% and more. That represents about 50% of African States
- The Average Overall El for AFRICA is 50,18%
- The Average Overall El for the World is 64,71%





# Effective Implementation of the 8 CE of an effective Safety Oversight System Status in Africa





# **Perspectives: Major Goals for 2017**

- 80% of African States to achieve 60% El and above
