

Goals for International Engagement

- Develop partnerships with the aim of steadily improving the safety of air traffic services and air traffic management through independent oversight
- Harmonize standards and procedures
- Promote risk-based oversight
- Promote data collection, exchange, and data-driven decisions
- Promote a non-punitive safety culture

Broad Areas of ATM Oversight required by ICAO

- Air traffic control services
- Safety personnel including ATCS and Technicians
- Flight procedures and flight inspection
- Communication, Navigation, and Surveillance services
- Aeronautical Telecommunication services
- Meteorological services
- Aeronautical Information Services and Aeronautical Information Management
- Cartographic services



Establishing a new oversight organization (Critical Elements 1 and 2)

- Legal underpinnings of authority
- Establishing an organization (position descriptions, etc.)
- Establishment of a base-line to begin oversight
- Transferring responsibilities from the existing service provider to the oversight organization so there is no disruption to the national airspace

- Agile oversight assessments
- Increasing collaboration to set standards

Raising the safety bar

Establish personnel qualifications and training (Critical Elements 4, 5 and 6)

 Air Traffic Safety inspector training and certification

 Air Traffic Controller and technician licensing/Credentialing

Risk-Based Surveillance (Critical Elements 7)

- Risk management
- Set performance indicators
- Mandate reporting
- Conduct risk-based audits
- Focus monitoring efforts (systematic)



Resolution of Safety Concerns

(Critical Element 8)

- Compliance Philosophy
- Strategies for getting voluntary compliance
- Set Standards
- Work with service providers and carriers
- Partner with neighboring oversight authorities
 - Data sharing, standards, indicators and requirements

Strategies for overseeing large organizations

- 1. Require ANSPs to use a safety management system (SMS) approach to safety
- 2. Require unfettered access to ANSP
- 3. Focus activities on risk (likelihood and severity)
- 4. Identify Safety Issues
- 5. Encourage a safety culture
- 6. Exploit all resources

Opportunities to support the improvement of ATM safety
