Regarding the Virtual Phase, we request that you designate at least two focal points from your State or International Organization, by **14 November 2025.** These representatives should have adequate expertise in the six fields concerned (AGA, CNS, ATM, SAR, MET, and AIM)or act as a State/International Organization coordinator, to analyze with counterparts and/or provide feedback on the meeting documentation and express the position of your administration on Draft Decisions/Conclusions or actions proposed in said documentation. Instructions for participating in the virtual phase will be provided timely to the designed focal points.

An opening session for this process will be held on 15 January 2026, via ZOOM (the link will be timely delivered to States and International Organizations). Subsequently, deliberations on the MS TEAMS platform will be held from 19 January to 12 February 2026.

GREPECAS/23 DRAFT AGENDA WITH EXPLANATORY NOTES

VIRTUAL PHASE

(Asynchronous, 19 January to 12 February 2026)

Agenda Item 1: Adoption of the Draft Agenda and Schedule

The Meeting will review the draft agenda and schedule, to adopt them. The objectives and overall expectations of the meeting will be presented.

Agenda Item 2: Follow-up on the Valid GREPECAS Conclusions and Decisions

Under this agenda item, a follow-up on the valid GREPECAS conclusions and decisions will be presented, for their update and check on their effective deployment. A detailed analysis will be carried out to identify improvements for the formulation, adoption, processing, and follow up of Decisions and Conclusions.

Agenda Item 3: Updates on GREPECAS-RASG-PA Joint activities

As a part of the GREPECAS-RASG-PA/5, a progress report of joint GREPECAS-RASG-PA activities will be presented, and the new goals to achieve jointly between both groups for the next activity period will be discussed.

Agenda Item 4: Assembly 42nd results; Global Aviation Safety Plan and Global Air Navigation Plan

As a part of the GREPECAS-RASG-PA/5, within the framework of the A42-WP /655 of the Technical Commission (Assembly Agenda Item 23) challenges on the adoption and implementation of Global Aviation Safety Plan 2026 - 2028 and the Global Air Navigation Plan- Eighth edition will be discussed.

The revised GASP presents the global strategy for the continuous improvement of aviation safety and is the master planning document upon which regional and national aviation safety plans are developed and implemented.

The GANP – Eighth edition, introduces: a) an update to the GANP strategy; b) guidance on the application of a performance-based approach to optimize the allocation of resources; c) an update to the GANP performance framework on environment and resilience; d) an update to the Aviation System Block Upgrade (ASBU) framework; and e) a mapping between the ASBU framework and the conceptual roadmap to enhance the visibility of the link between the strategic and technical levels. A working table will be held during the in-person phase.

Agenda Item 5: Assembly 42nd Results; Matters Concerning Air Navigation Initiatives

GREPECAS/23 meeting will discuss the results of Assembly 42 on Air navigation performance initiatives, as follows:

a) Outcomes of the Fourteenth Air Navigation Conference (AN-Conf/14) and the follow-up actions undertaken by ICAO.

- b) ICAO policy on Radio Frequency (RF) spectrum matters
- c) Global Navigation Satellite System (GNSS) vulnerabilities and resilience
- d) Meteorology and System-Wide Information Management (SWIM)
- e) Aerodrome operations and obstacle limitation surfaces
- f) Aerodrome infrastructure and certification
- g) Space transport operations

Agenda Item 6: Progress on Regional and National Air Navigation Planning

Under this agenda item, the progress on updating the CAR/SAM Regional Air Navigation Plan Volumes I, II, and III will be reviewed. Also, initiatives to improve the regional (RANP) and national air navigation (NANP) planning and to produce adequate ASBU implementation reports and Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) assessment will be presented.

The GANP KPI Ad hoc group (GADHOC) will present its advances. GREPECAS/23 will be informed on:

- a) KPIs management development
- b) Volume III improvements. Metrics for ASBU Implementation

Agenda Item 7: GREPECAS Work Programme and Projects

Under this agenda Item, the Meeting will follow up the implementation of the Decision/22/14 – 'Review of the current GREPECAS work programme and projects', including the initial alignment to ICAO Strategic Plan 2026-2050 and the update to GREPECAS Air Navigation Deficiencies Database (GANDD) deficiencies.

Agenda Item 8: CAR/SAM Air Navigation Implementation

Under this agenda item, in order to provide more significant products and results through the work of GREPECAS, the Meeting will analyze the implementation of ASBU modules and elements in the CAR/SAM Regions, as well as other initiatives to improve air navigation. Regional priorities, constraints and related challenges will be identified.

This Item will address the following areas: Air traffic management (ATM), Airspace optimization, Air Traffic Flow Management (AFTM), Search and Rescue (SAR), Communications, Navigation and Surveillance (CNS), Aeronautical Meteorology (MET), Aeronautical Information Management (AIM), Aerodromes and Ground Aids (AGA) and Environmental Protection (ENV).

Agenda Item 9: Other business to be addressed in the virtual phase

Under this agenda item, other matters can be addressed to be discussed in the virtual/asynchronous phase.

IN-PERSON PHASE (Mexico City, Mexico, 4 to 6 March 2026)

Agenda Item 10: Preliminary Results from GREPECAS23 Virtual Phase

Following the adopted agenda and schedule, the results of the preliminary discussion of topics emanating from the virtual phase (asynchronous) will be presented, as well as the relevant implementation items to be addressed during the in-person phase meeting. Updates of the Agenda of the virtual phase.

Agenda Item 11: Strategic Approach Towards the Implementation of Air Navigation Improvements

Under this agenda item, a proposal for a strategic model for the implementation of air navigation priorities will be presented to grant the alignment of all components of GREPECAS programme B (Air Navigation Implementation Programme aligned with the GANP, ASBU Framework, and Performance Framework) to the ICAO Strategic Plan 2026 – 2050 and the implementation in progress. This model should allow States and international organizations to better identify the priorities in the CAR/SAM Regions. A working table will be developed.

Agenda Item 12: Review of GREPECAS Work Programme

Based on the deliberations and comments received from the virtual phase (asynchronous), as well as the analysis of the updated GASP and GANP requirements, the Meeting will review the Planning and Implementation Regional Groups (PIRGs) and Regional aviation safety groups (RASGs) global challenges. The Meeting will discuss and approve the GREPECAS updated work programme and other related issues.

Agenda Item 13: Any Other Business

Other matters can be addressed, particularly in preparation for the next GREPECAS meeting.

Agenda Item 14: Draft GREPECAS 23 Conclusions and Decisions

The results of the GREPECAS/23 meeting will be presented (virtual and in-person sessions) in the form of Draft Conclusions and Decisions.
