BACKGROUND



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1. Mauritius has one international airport and one domestic airport
2. Effective interventions at points of entry played a crucial role in preventing the international spread of communicable diseases
3. Mauritius joined CAPSCA on 19 April 2023
4. The CAPSCA assistance visit was concurrently held with a Point of Entry Workshop from 30 July to 02 August 2024

- 5 Measures adopted during different phases
- 6 Actions to a suspected case being identified in flight
- 7 Action by pilot in command and ATC
