Dear Sir/Madam,

I am pleased to refer to the program of activities of the Regional Project RLA/06/901 and invite you to participate in the Thirty Third Workshop/Meeting of the South American Region Implementation Group (SAM/IG/33), which will be held at the ICAO offices in Lima, Peru from August 11 to 15 of this year.

This Workshop/Meeting aims to continue the technical activities linked to the implementation of the Regional Air Navigation Plan, as well as to the regional initiatives to improve the ATM/CNS. During this event, the works and deliverables developed by the GESEA and GT INTEROP technical study groups will be presented. The development of the Regional Air Navigation Plan and the promotion of GREPECAS programs will be addressed.

For a more detailed analysis of the matters to be discussed, the provisional Agenda with its explanatory notes and tentative Work Program (**Attachment A**) is included, which is considering that the Twentieth Meeting of the Coordination Committee (RCC/20) will be held on Thursday, August 14, 2025, in the afternoon.

Please note that the event will be held in Spanish and will have simultaneous interpretation into English. For SAM/IG/33, the participation of the Director of air navigation services or officer responsible for the implementation and improvement of such services, who should be empowered to make decisions on behalf of his or her State, is considered of utmost importance and priority. In addition, the delegation should include a CNS officer (work of the GT INTEROP) and an ATM officer (work of the GESEA). The profile of the participants and the objectives of the event are presented in the Mnemonic Sheet (**Attachment B**).

To guide the discussions of the Workshop/Meeting, States should submit the working papers and Information Notes on agenda items. Working papers must be sent to this Regional Office in Spanish and English. On the other hand, the Information Notes must be sent in the language(s) decided by the originator

All documentation should be submitted no later than **July 18, 2025**, to be posted on the event website by **August 1st, 2025**, in order to facilitate early review by specialists and the Secretariat. Notes submitted after the above deadlines may be included in the documentation for the subsequent SAM/IG Workshop/Meeting scheduled for October 2026, subject to coordination with the Secretariat.
