OVERVIEW OF THE AFI CIS PROGRAM

- ☐ Established in 2012 with ICAO & RSOO support.
- Comprises a pool of qualified inspectors from Member States.
- ☐ Objectives: Resolve SSCs, improve EI, and strengthen oversight systems.
- Inspector pool expanded from 50 → 150 experts (ICAO ESAF/WACAF support).
- Expanded domains: AIG, SSP, DG.

11 AFI-CIS technical assistance missions to 6 States were conducted in 2025.

Capacity Building – HRDF is set to commence training programs – to also benefit AFI CIS inspectors








3 SSC States

60 identified Infrastructure Gaps attributed to aging equipment at Airports, ANSPs and Airlines


Low level of accident data sharing among member States and RSOOs
