## Global mental health in 2025

Mental health conditions are widespread, undertreated and under-resourced

#### **UNDER-RESOURCED**





# **Understanding mental health**

Exists on a complex continuum, experienced differently by different persons



# Mental health and work (WHO)

- <u>15%</u> of working-age adults have a mental disorder at any point in time
- Meaningful work protective for mental health: sense of accomplishment, confidence
- <u>Negative effects</u> of poor mental health: cognitive, behavioural, emotional, social, relational well-being & functioning, physical health, personal identity
- Negative effects of poor mental health on work
  - Impaired capacity to participate in work
  - Reduction in productivity and performance
  - Reduction in the ability to work safely
  - Difficulty in retaining or gaining work





# Factors affecting mental health in aviation





## Mental health challenges in aviation

- Stigma and discrimination (perceived and real)
- Self-esteem and self-confidence
- Reluctance to seek help
- Seeking help, but declining treatment
- Obtaining treatment, but non-disclosure
- Peers hesitant to report concerns to employer
- Increasing stress and isolation
- Adverse effect on the progression of disease
- Increased risk to aviation safety





# **Current snapshot of mental health in aviation**

- Magnitude of mental health problems and disorders in aviation unknown
- <u>Majority of mental disorders</u>: depression, anxiety, alcohol and drug dependence
- Potential certification consequences
  - Additional costs examinations & treatment
  - Grounding
  - Loss of income
  - Loss of medical certification
  - Loss of employment



## **Responsibilities of all stakeholders**

- Multi-stakeholder <u>collaboration</u>
- Recognize different <u>cultural approaches</u>
- Promote a common understanding of supportive behaviors and activities
- Provide a psycho-socially safe and supportive environment

## **Responsibilities of National Aviation Authorities**

- Ensure collaboration: aviation medical examiners, healthcare professionals, peer support groups, aviation personnel
- Provide guidance and support to aviation medical examiners
- Encourage stakeholders to make available appropriate resources and tools
- Communicate on a regular basis to all stakeholders the means to maintain licensing and proficiency to enable safe performance of duties

## **Responsibilities of Industry Service Providers**

- Raise awareness to leadership and management
- Offer resources such as EAP or other programs
- <u>Inform aviation personnel</u> of other available resources
- <u>Facilitate access</u> to support programs
- Educate on fitness for duty and self-care
- <u>Encourage</u> development and provisions of <u>training</u>
   <u>programmes</u>
- Ensure <u>safety management system</u> addresses concerns





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## **Responsibilities of aviation personnel**

- Practice self-care in all dimensions:
   nutrition, exercise, sleep, reduce
   stressors, healthy behaviour, interaction
   with a personal support network
- <u>Seek support pro-actively</u> to maintain well-being and <u>encourage fellow</u> <u>employees</u> to seek support as needed.





## **Responsibilities of Aviation Medical Examiners & Healthcare Professionals**

- Provide a supportive environment
- Proactively <u>discuss</u> work-related challenges
- Refer for further appropriate support
- Update contact details to facilitate referral
- Refer to health professionals as appropriate where peer support groups are not available or where more professional support is needed.









## **Peer support**

- <u>Definition</u> of peers
- <u>Dimensions</u> of peer support
- <u>Principles</u>: emotionally safe, nonjudgmental, confidential, independence, supervision, consideration of SMS aspects









Sudden & subtle incapacitation

 Literature review, incident and accident data, performance data, medical examination data, peer reports

Cognitive functioning

• Literature review, performance data, cognitive testing, peer reports

Risk mitigation


 Qualitative and quantitative, bow-tie, risk matrices, Swiss Cheese mitigation measures, acceptable risk threshold

The future

 Research, data analysis, data driven algorithmic risk modelling, consider new types of operations: single pilot, remote pilots, etc.





# ICAO 2025 Report on the State of Global Aviation Safety

Article: The role of Health Promotion and Mental Wellbeing in Enhancing Aviation Safety

The value of health promotion, mental wellbeing advocacy and the ultimate effective application of individualized risk management should not be underestimated in terms of building trust within the aviation medical system and the resultant effect of enhanced aviation safety



## **Peer support Programmes (PSPs)**

- Importance of implementing PSPs
- Licence holders and safety-sensitive workers
- Collaboration between all aviation stakeholders
- Caution: do not link PSPs to medical certification

#### **Substances**

Framework for evaluating use of psycho-active substances

#### Health promotion and assessment

- Value of national preventive activities
- Include in aviation medical examinations

#### **Aviation security personnel**

- Global guidance for mental health risk assessment
- No psychological/ mental health screening by AME





#### Data-based risk management and decision-making in aviation medicine

- Standardized data collection to inform evidence-based SARPs
- Global framework for managing in-flight passenger health emergencies
- Guidance to implement Aviation Health Management system based on SMS principles
- Enhance data generation and collection, strengthen the aviation medical system to safely support considering a future increase in the age limit
