SAFETY MATCHES PERMITTED FOR CARRIAGE BY PASSENGERS

(Presented by G.A. Leach)

1. **INTRODUCTION**

1.1 At WG/05, a slight change was made to Part 8;1.1.2 (g) in that a passenger would be restricted to one small "book" of safety matches. However, the report of that meeting suggests that one small "packet" was agreed upon which would take account of small boxes as well as books. It is suggested the text should be amended to reflect the decision taken at WG/05.

2. **PROPOSAL**

2.1 Amend the text agreed at WG/05 as follows:

g) <u>no more than one small book-packet of</u> safety matches or one lighter intended for use by an individual when carried on the person and not in checked or carry-on baggage. However, Lighters containing unabsorbed liquid fuel (other than liquefied gas), lighter fuel and lighter refills are not permitted on one's person or in checked or carry-on baggage;
