## 1. **INTRODUCTION**

1.1 Part 7; 4.7 requires that an operator must ensure that notices providing information about dangerous goods are prominently displayed at cargo acceptance areas.

1.2 Unlike the equivalent provision of information for passengers, 7; 5.1.2, there is no recognition that for cargo acceptance the facility may be under control of a handling agent. Many operators use the services of a handling agent for the acceptance of cargo, including dangerous goods, as they use a handling agent for processing of passengers, it is therefore appropriate that the provision of information in cargo acceptance areas reflect that fact.

## 2. **PROPOSAL**

2.1 Align the text of Part 7;4.7 with the text in 7; 5.1.2 by amending it as follows:

An operator <u>or his handling agent shall must</u> ensure that notices sufficient in number and prominently displayed, are provided at acceptance points for cargo giving information about the transport of dangerous goods.
