1. **INTRODUCTION**

- 1.1 WP/7 page 9 proposes some changes to Packing Instruction 650 as a result of the decisions taken at WG/05.
- 1.2 Paragraph 2) c) is changed in the proposal as follows:
 - c) an <u>rigid</u> outer packaging <u>of which either the secondary or the outer packaging must</u> <u>be rigid</u>.
- 1.3 According to the report of WG/05 paragraph 6.1.7 the current text of the 2005-2006 edition must be retained.

2. **PROPOSAL**

- 2.1 Retain the current text of the 2005-2006 edition
 - 2) c) an rigid outer packaging
- 2.2 Amendment to Packing Instruction 650 13) must be made in accordance with the decisions taken on WP 50 and flimsy 7 during WG/05.
 - 13) A quantity of 30 ml or less of dangerous goods included in classes 3,8 or 9 may be packed in each primary receptacle containing infectious substances <u>provided these</u> substances meet the requirements of 1;2.4.2 and 1;2.4.3. When these small....
