## **CONTENT OF TRAINING COURSES**

(Presented by G. A. Leach)

### 1. **INTRODUCTION**

- 1.1 Two anomalies have been noted in the Key and associated Note related to Table 1-4 "Content of training courses".
- 1.1.2 Firstly, Category of personnel column 5 refers to security staff who deal with the screening of passengers and their baggage. It is questioned why this does not extend to security staff who deal with cargo.
- 1.1.3 Secondly, the Note suggests that cargo operators need not train their flight crews in aspects relating to passengers. However, part 8 of the Technical Instructions is entitled "Provisions concerning passengers and crew". Consequently, it is suggested that flight crew of cargo aircraft should receive training in this area.

# 2. **PROPOSAL**

- 2.1 It is proposed to amend the Key to Table 1-4 as follows:
  - "5- Passenger-handling staff and security staff who deal with the screening of passengers and their baggage; and security staff who deal with the screening of cargo."

2.1.1 It is further proposed to amend the Note under the Key to Table 1-4 as follows:

"Note - Depending on the responsibilities......should be familiar. If an operator carries only cargo, those aspects relating to passengers may be omitted from staff and flight crew training.
