EXCEPTION FOR DANGEROUS GOODS OF THE OPERATOR

(Presented by G A Leach)

1. **INTRODUCTION**

1.1 Part 1; 2.2.1 b) of the Technical Instructions provides for certain dangerous goods to be carried on board passenger aircraft if they are for sale or use on the aircraft. The list of permitted items includes aerosols and it is questioned why this alleviation does not extend to cargo aircraft where aerosols may be carried for use e.g. for fumigation, air freshening etc. A small change to the wording would rectify this apparent anomaly.

2. **PROPOSAL**

Amend Part 1; 2.2.1 b) of the Technical Instructions as follow:

- 2.2.1 The provisions of these Instructions do not apply to the following:
 - b) aerosols, alcoholic beverages, perfumes, colognes, safety matches and liquefied gas lighters carried aboard an passenger aircraft by the operator for use or sale............
