Fred Stein currently works for the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) as the Acting Director of Runway Safety. Previously he has served as Manager of the Safety Management Branch in the Air Traffic Safety Oversight Service where he was responsible for the oversight of the FAA's Air Traffic Organization's Safety Management System (SMS).

Mr. Stein served as the ISO 9001:2008 Management Representative for the Flight Standards Service (AFS) from 2008 to 2010. In that capacity he was responsible for establishing, implementing and maintaining the AFS Quality Management System (QMS). He is an RABQSA Certified AS9100 Aerospace Industry and ISO 9001:2008 Auditor.

Mr. Stein served in various management positions within the FAA to include Manager of the Eastern Region Flight Standards Technical with responsibilities for planning, directing and monitoring airworthiness and operations technical programs and activities of 18 field offices, including four International Field Offices, in support of agency, regional, and division goals and objectives. He also served as the Manager of the London International Field Office with responsibility and authority for all decision-making in a wide variety of technical areas to include certification, surveillance, investigation, enforcement and investigation of all aviation activities occurring within the United Kingdom and Iceland involving 14 CFR Part 145 Certificated Foreign Repair Stations.

Mr. Stein is a qualified Airline Transport Pilot rating with an L-1011 type rating. He is a qualified Flight Engineer: Turbojet Powered/FE. In the United States Air Force he has served as a C-141 Instructor Pilot/Aircraft Commander with operations experience flying into a wide variety of military and civilian international airports.
