Stephen trained as a Flight Service Officer with the Civil Aviation Authority (CAA) in 1989, before transferring to Air Traffic Control in 1993 working at Airservices Melbourne Enroute Centre. After a number of years, as an operational controller, Stephen relocated to Airservices Head Office in Canberra to manage airspace projects.

In 2005, Stephen was appointed to General Manager, Airspace Environment and Regulatory Unit (AERU) and was Australia's airspace safety regulator. Stephen was appointed to General Manager, National Operations Centre (NOC) and provided management and oversight of the construction and implementation of Airservices Australia's first consolidated strategic traffic management centre based in Canberra. This included contingency management and crisis and disaster response capability.

In 2008 Stephen was appointed to his current role as the General Manager, Safety & Assurance and is accountable for Airservices Safety Management System (SMS), Occupational Health and Safety System, Enterprise Risk, Corporate Security, Project Safety and Audit.

Stephen is the Chairman of the Civil Air Navigation Services Organisation's (CANSO) Safety Steering Committee.
