- Problem areas are different



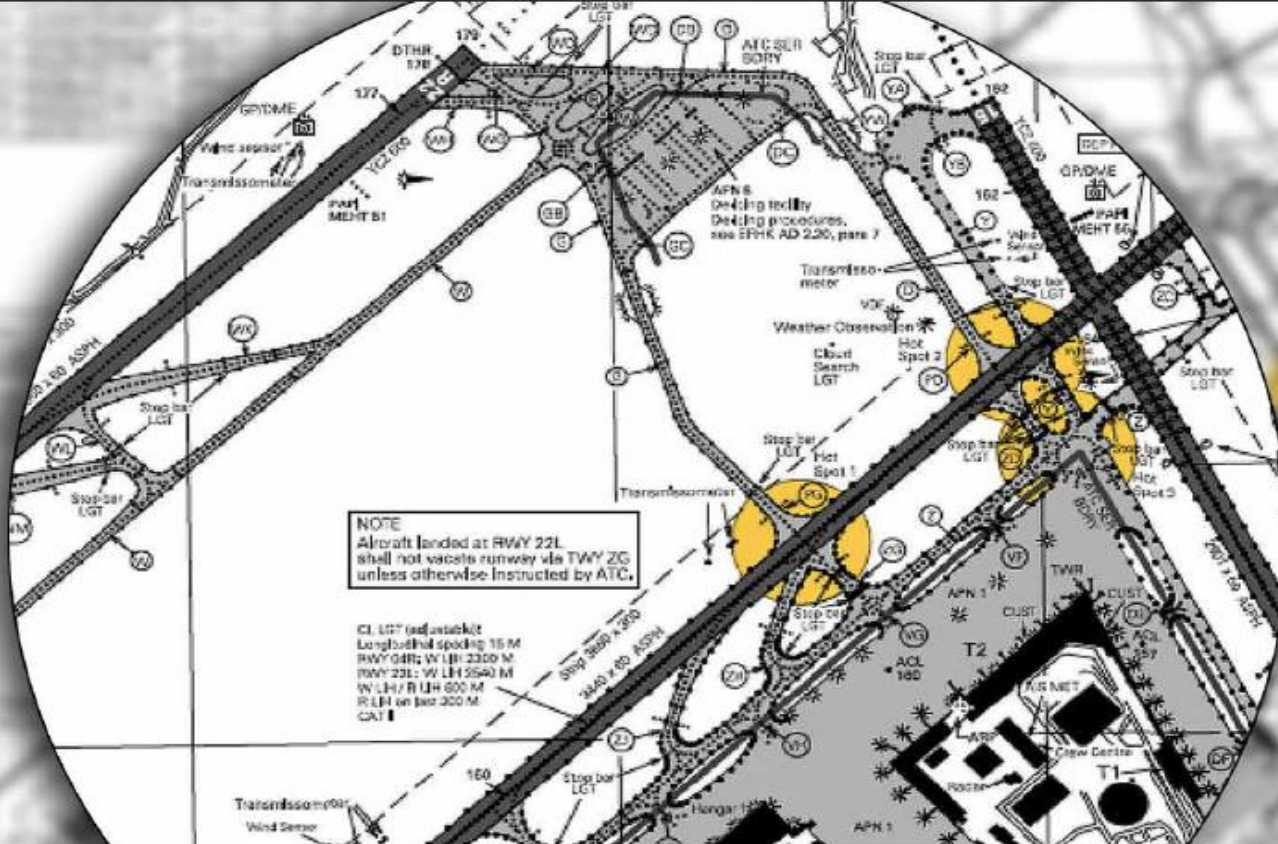




What do Local Runway Safety Teams achieve?

- Address known problem areas
- Monitor occurrences
- Disseminate lessons learned
- Raise awareness
- Implement improvement measures

Always use full call signs

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Runway Incursion Prevention

Incomplete/Incorrect transmission is not a readback - Challenge!

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Runway Incursion Prevention

Stopbars unserviceable? Use contingency measures

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Runway Incursion Prevention

ICAO rules apply Joint use civil-military aerodromes

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Runway Safety

- A difficult and complex issue - no single solution
 - Aerodromes are different but ...
 - Local Runway Safety Teams are key
 - Harmonisation by ICAO is essential
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- Runway Safety deserves raised awareness
 - Lessons must be shared on a global level
