## Follow-up to ICAO RSOO Study (*published mid 2021*)

- On-going, to be finalised in September 2024
- Proposed 3 stage path to improve RSOO efficiency:
  - *Consolidation phase*
  - *Maturation phase*
  - *Optimisation phase*
- Proposal to develop AIG capacity in the AFI region
- Outcome of the study will be presented in Q4 2024

- Will cover issues like:

  - Market
  - NGAP
- Contract signature foreseen for Q1 2025
- Project start date planned for mid-2025
