The Manual of Air Traffic Control Instructions is issued under Commission Regulation (EC) No 2096/2005 of 20 Dec 2005 laying down common requirements for the provision of air navigation services which has legal status in Malta.

Malta will adopt Directive 2006/23/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 April 2006 on a Community air traffic controller licence. Adoption is expected by May this year. All air traffic controllers have already been tested by a language specialist and meet the Annex 1 requirements.
