Reservation: "The above acceptance is based on the understanding . . . that the provisions of Article II, Section 2 of the International Air Services Transit Agreement shall become operative as to the Commonwealth of the Philippines at such time as the Convention on International Civil Aviation shall be ratified in accordance with the Constitution and laws of the Philippines". (The Philippine Instrument of Ratification of the Convention on International Civil Aviation was deposited on 1/3/47.)

Reservation: "Article 2, paragraph 1, of the Convention shall not apply to international air transport effected by the Republic of the Philippines".

- The instrument of accession by the Philippines contains the following declaration in accordance with Article 57: "the Convention shall not apply to:

  - b) the carriage of persons, cargo and baggage for its military authorities on aircraft registered in or leased by the Philippines, the whole capacity of which has been reserved by or on behalf of such authorities."
