Mr. Enkhbayar Lkhagvasuren brings over 16 years of experience in international law, security, and public administration. Since May 2023, he has served as Senior Protection Associate at UNHCR Mongolia, supporting refugee protection and humanitarian efforts.

Previously, he led Mongolia's AML/CFT strategy as Head of Division at the National Counter Terrorism Council (2020–2023), contributing to Mongolia's removal from the FATF grey list. Under his leadership, the Council launched joint programs with UNOCT, UNODC, INTERPOL, OSCE TNTD, and SCO RATS. He also served as the national focal point to UNOCT, UNODC, the UNSCR 1540 Committee, and OSCE TNTD.

From 2015 to 2019, he was Senior Expert and Secretary-General of the National Counter Terrorism Council, leading outreach to public and private sectors, drafting key national legislation—including laws on anti-terrorism, AML/CFT, and non-profit organizations—and developing operational manuals on targeted financial sanctions.

Mr. Enkhbayar holds advanced degrees in security, international law, and public administration and has completed specialized training in over 10 countries in areas including security, human rights, and financial crime prevention.
