Sir/Madam,

1. I have the honour to refer to the jointly established Republic of Korea and International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) Developing Countries Training Programme, which is sponsored by the Office of Civil Aviation at the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure and Transport (MOLIT) and administered by ICAO. Since 2001, the Training Programme has welcomed 3,564 personnel from 140 Member States. With a great partnership and active support from ICAO, the Republic of Korea successfully delivered the 2025 Training Programme, which benefited 206 personnel from 63 Member States.

2. I am pleased to announce that in 2026, under the above Programme, training will be offered to 130 trainees from developing States for ten (10) courses. Details on the courses offered as well as the terms and conditions applicable to these fellowships are explained in Attachments A to C. It is important to note, however, that the course content and course delivery for non-ICAO courses are outside the Organization's purview and hence the sole responsibility of MOLIT. Applicants are required to complete the online application form at www.korea-ftp.org. Kindly note that States that submit applications will be informed of the results of the selection process at least three weeks prior to the commencement of the course.

THE 2026 REPUBLIC OF KOREA - ICAO TRAINING PROGRAMME FOR AVIATION PERSONNEL

1. OVERVIEW

1.1 The Republic of Korea (ROK) has launched the Training Programme to contribute to the evolution and safety of the world’s aviation industry since 2001. In 2006, ROK and ICAO, recognizing the importance of assistance and cooperation in the aviation training, established the training programme which is sponsored by the Government of the ROK and administered by the ICAO Capacity Development and Implementation Bureau, and conducted by the Civil Aviation Training Centre of Korea Airports Corporation (CATC) and Incheon Airport Aviation Academy (IAAA).

In accordance with this MOU, the ROK will invite 130 (KAC) trainees from the ICAO Member States and deliver the courses as below in 2026.

3. TRAINING INSTITUTES

a) The Civil Aviation Training Centre (CATC)

The Civil Aviation Training Centre (CATC) of Korea Airports Corporation was established in 1984 with the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) and ICAO aid for the improvement of technical expertise to contribute to the safety and development of the civil aviation industry. CATC offers specialized training courses for domestic and international trainees to foster global-minded human resources experts in the air navigation system, airport management and operations, air traffic control, and other fields of the aviation industry. Furthermore, CATC has been certified as a TRAINAIR PLUS Regional Training Centre of Excellence since 2015.

CATC is staffed with excellent instructors and equipped with state of the art, practical training facilities. Trainees will be staying in CATC dormitory and will have access to its amenities.

<p>Training Facilities and Equipment</p>	<p>Ten lecture rooms and two seminar rooms are fully equipped with audio-visual aids such as beam projectors and video presentation aids.</p> <p><i>(Intl' building)</i> Training equipment and electronic calibrators are provided for every course to allow practical training: DVOR/DME, ILS, radar simulator, U/VHF telecommunication equipment, GPS training equipment, network training equipment, and over 30 test equipment including oscilloscopes and spectrum analyzers.</p>
<p>Dormitory</p>	<p>Trainees will stay in dormitory (one room per person) equipped with air conditioning and heating, and served with meals that different nationalities can enjoy. Gym, movie theater, and karaoke are also available for the trainees' use.</p>



b) Incheon Airport Aviation Academy (IAAA)

Incheon Airport Aviation Academy (IAAA) was recognized as an ICAO Regional Training Centre of Excellence (RTCE) in September 2014 and achieved Platinum membership in the ICAO TRAINAIR PLUS Programme (TPP). IAAA is authorized to develop and deliver ICAO Training Packages in the following areas: Aerodromes, Air Navigation, Flight Safety, and Safety Management. As a TRAINAIR PLUS Member, IAAA has developed and operated eight TRAINAIR PLUS Standardized Training Packages (STPs) and three ICAO Training Packages (ITPs) for domestic and international trainees.

Moreover, IAAA has been designated as an ACI GTH (Global Training Hub) in the Asia-Pacific Region in 2007 and became an ACI ATP (Accredited Training Partner) in 2023. Additionally, IAAA was designated as an ITC (IATA Training Centre) in 2017 and certified as an RTP (Regional Training Partner) by IATA in October 2023.

IAAA offers practical training courses tailored to the needs of various aviation fields. These courses combine theoretical lectures with hands-on training, including airport operation experiences, on-site visits, and workshops designed to enhance problem-solving skills.

Training Facilities and Equipment	26 different-sized classrooms, including a banquet hall and auditorium, 5 group workrooms, a multi-media computer lab, an online lecture room, an ATC (Apron Traffic Control) simulator, and an AVSEC (Aviation Security) training lab equipped with a Walk-through Metal Detector, a Security Scanner, and a Tray Return System.
Dormitory	There are 102 hotel-style guest rooms (VIP, single, and double rooms) fully furnished with air conditioning/heating, LCD TVs, and internet access. For recreation, a football field, a jogging track, a tennis court, a basketball court, a pool table, table tennis, a fitness center, and a sauna are available free of charge. In addition, there is also a business center with internet access, fax, a photocopy machine, and magazines.



c) Training contents

Courses consist of classroom lectures, practical training, and on-site visits. In particular, trainees will meet with senior officials for aviation safety and air navigation system, and discuss cooperation.

Trainees will also have opportunities to visit Incheon Airport, Gimpo Airport, air traffic control facilities, the aviation museum, and other important aviation facilities, in addition to experiencing Korean culture on a visit to historical palaces and other popular tourist spots.

All trainees should complete the Attachment B Participant’s Itinerary for airport escort service and send it to the training institute, as guided, after being selected, at least 14 days before the training start date. More information of accommodation and transportation will be provided by the training institute 3 weeks before start of the training.
