



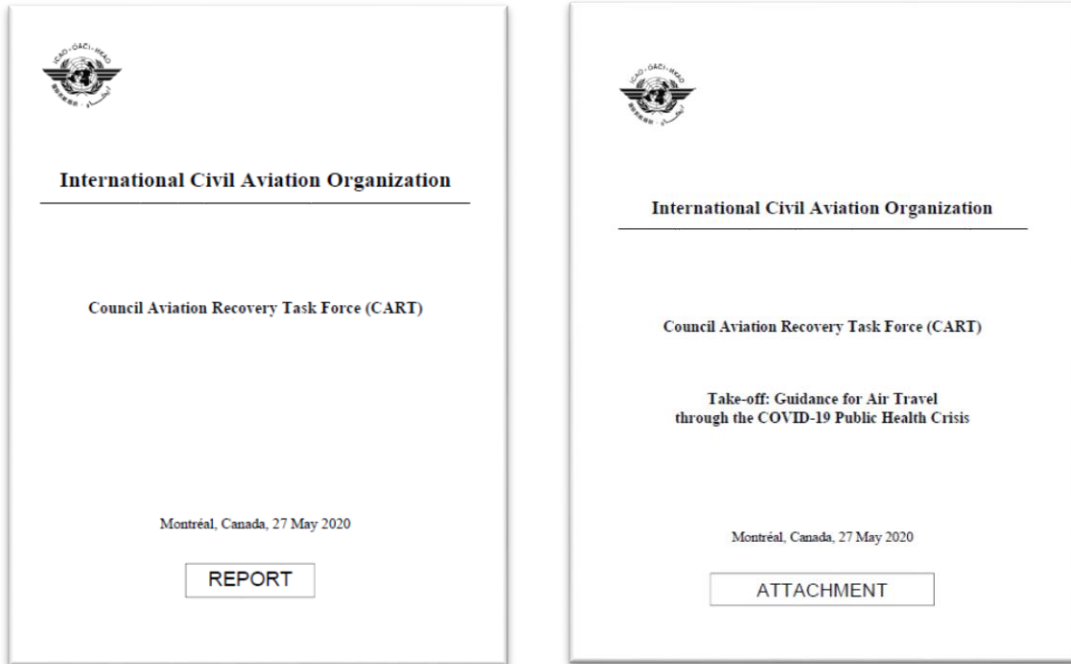

Expedite hold bags delivery

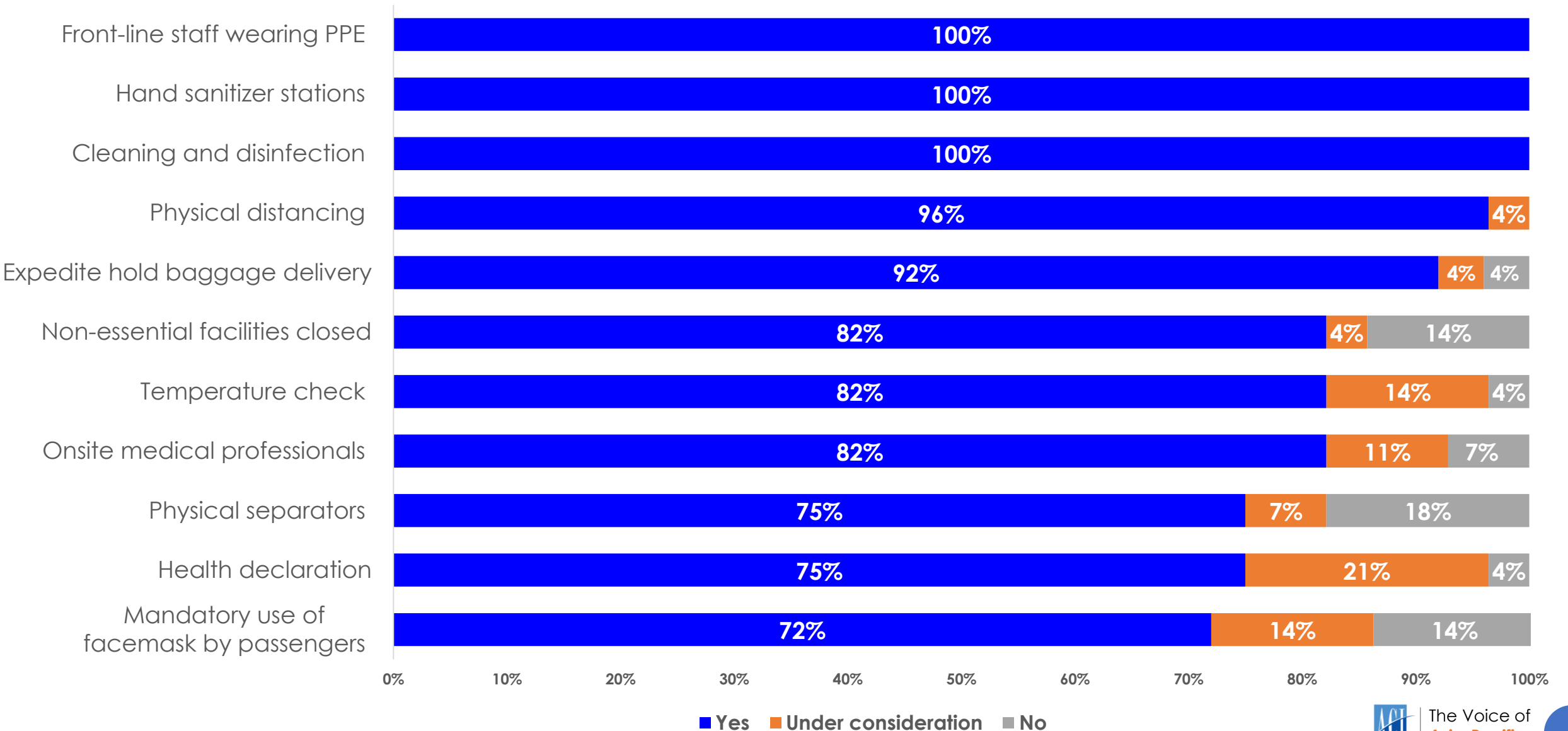


Use of face mask by pax

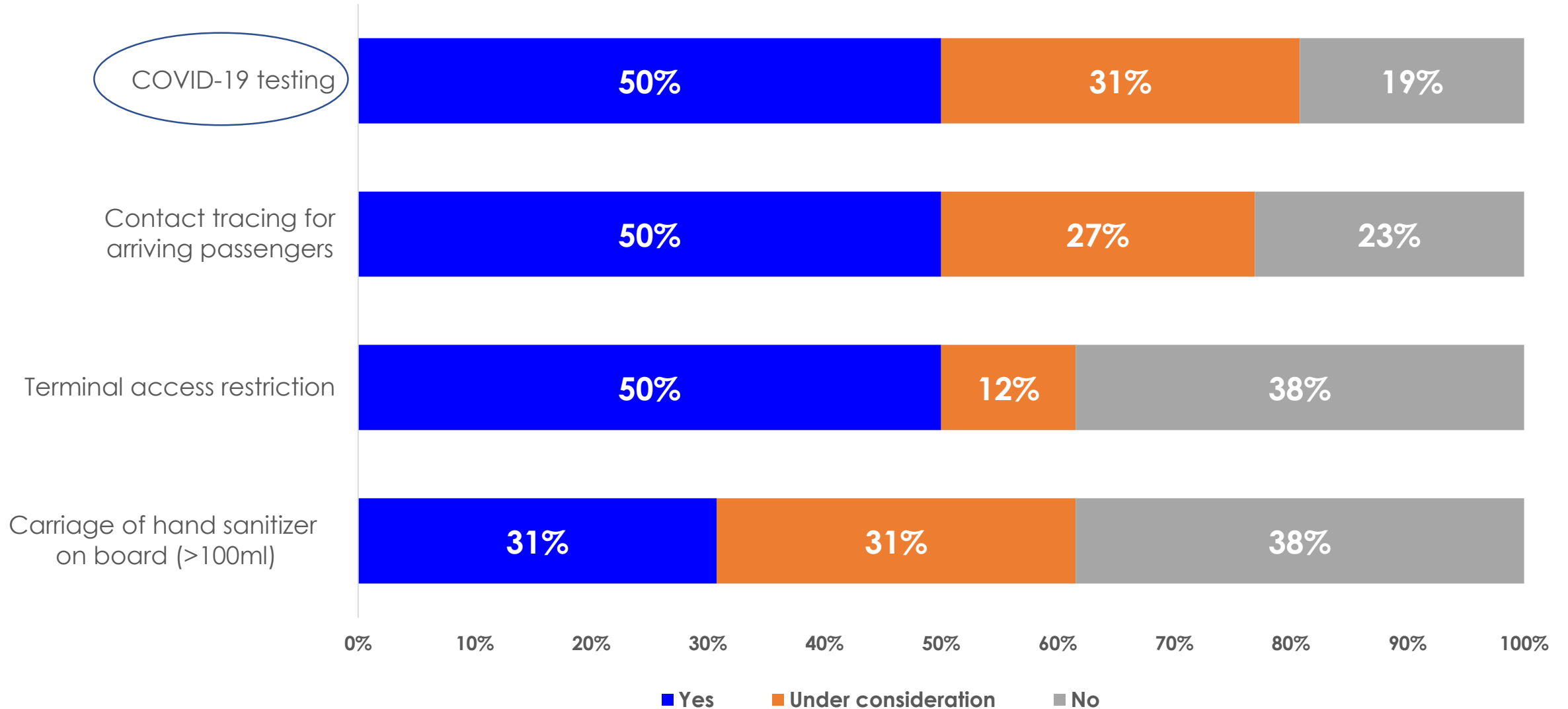


Health declaration

But some measures are less widely adopted

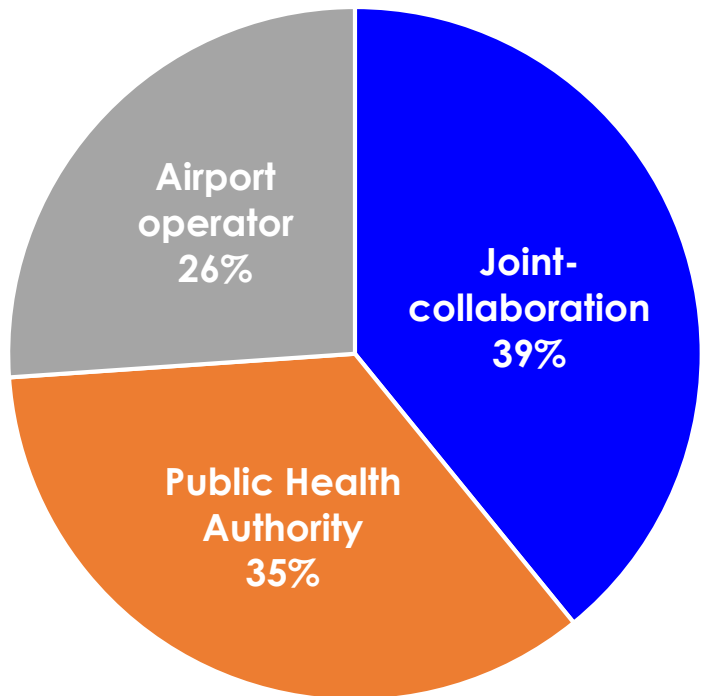


Generally less common as they are set by public authorities

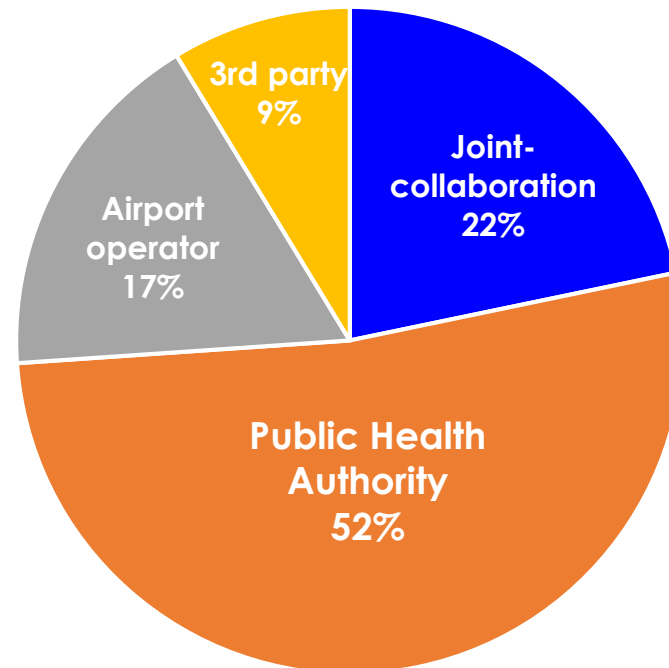
CART implementation concerns for airports

Who to buy the equipment?

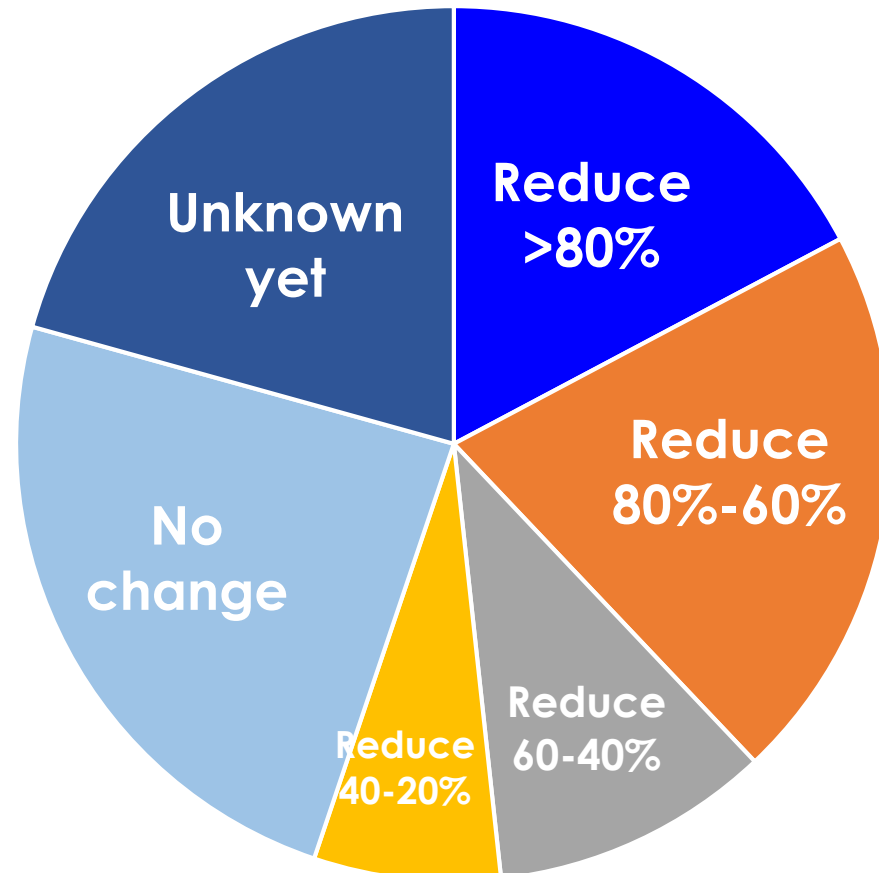


Who to operate?



CART implementation concerns for airports

- 2) Impacts to airport operations due to additional health measures
 - e.g. reduction in passenger handling capacity

ACI suggestions for operational restart

- COVID-19 Testing at departure
 - onsite arriving testing at airports will not be practical
- Social distancing at every stage a challenge in the long-term
 - A multi-layer of measures to prevent transmission
- Public financing for health screening measures
 - cost should be borne by governments (e.g. COVID testing fee)
- Cooperation & coordination among all stakeholders for restart
 - ICAO, States (CAA & public health authority) and industry
