# COVID-19 Government Public Health Mitigation Measures Dashboard

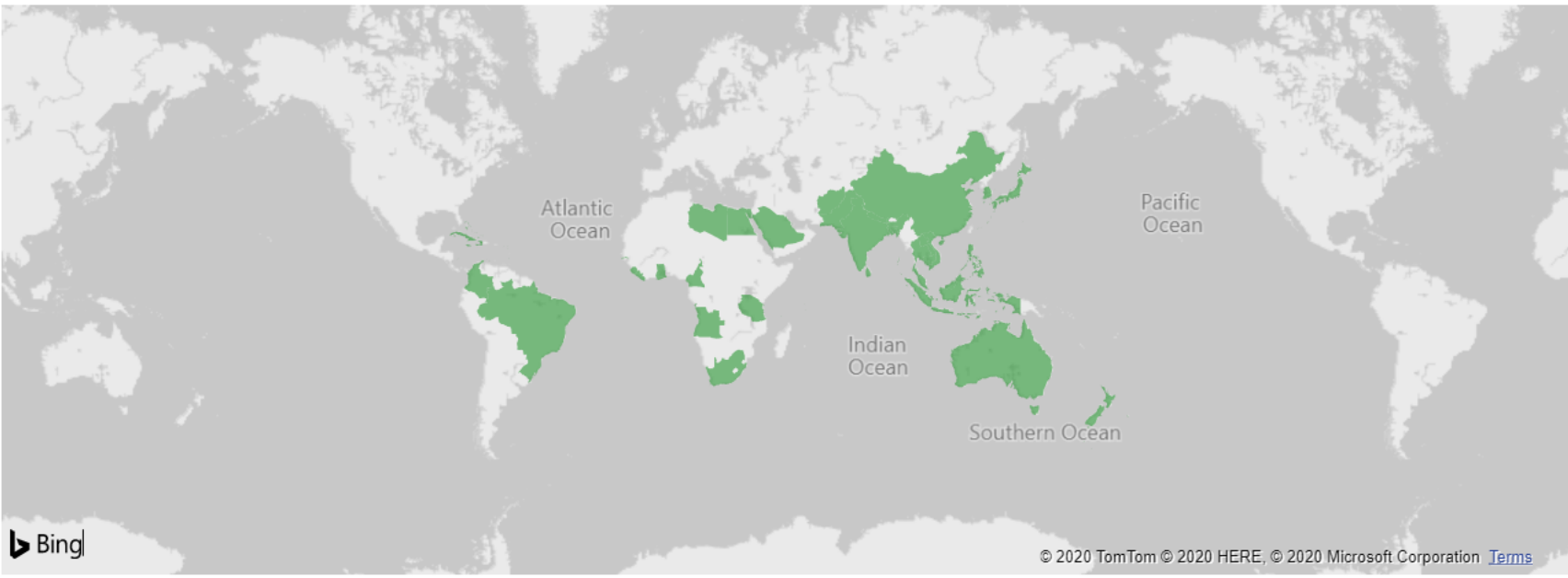

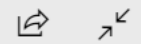

**Lack of exemptions for crew** (More details to follow)

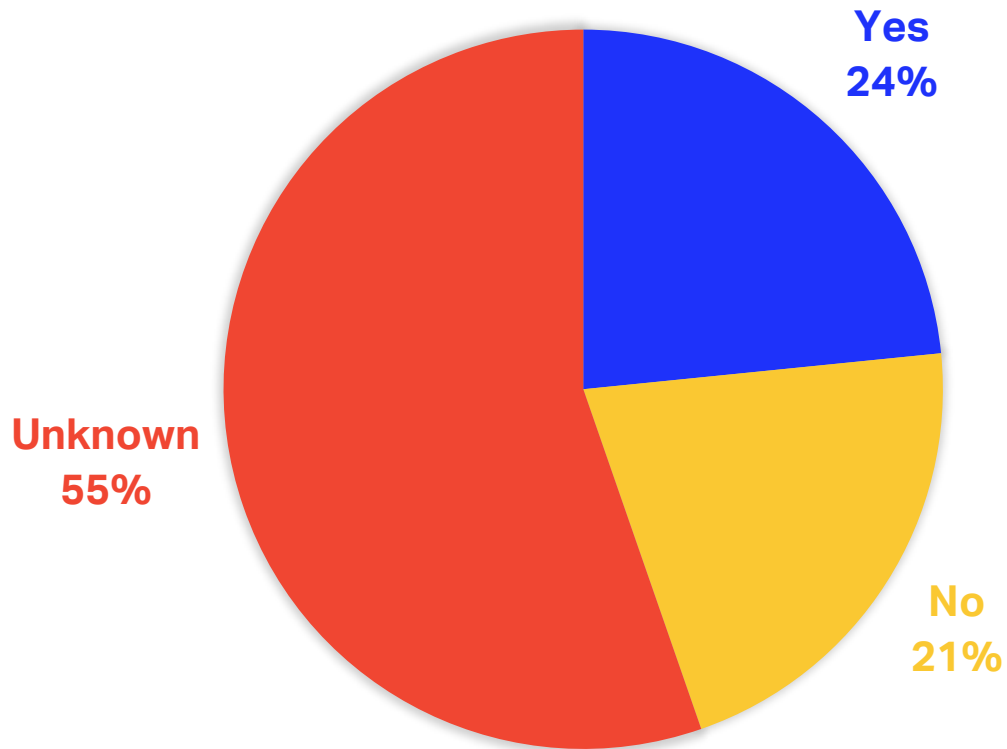


## **Other challenges in Airline Facilitation:**

- Retention of passenger health certificate and insurance documents for use by government;
- Ensuring every passenger has filled out the health declaration form;
- Temperature screening for departing passengers

# Are crew exempted enough?

## CREW COVID-19 TESTING EXEMPTION

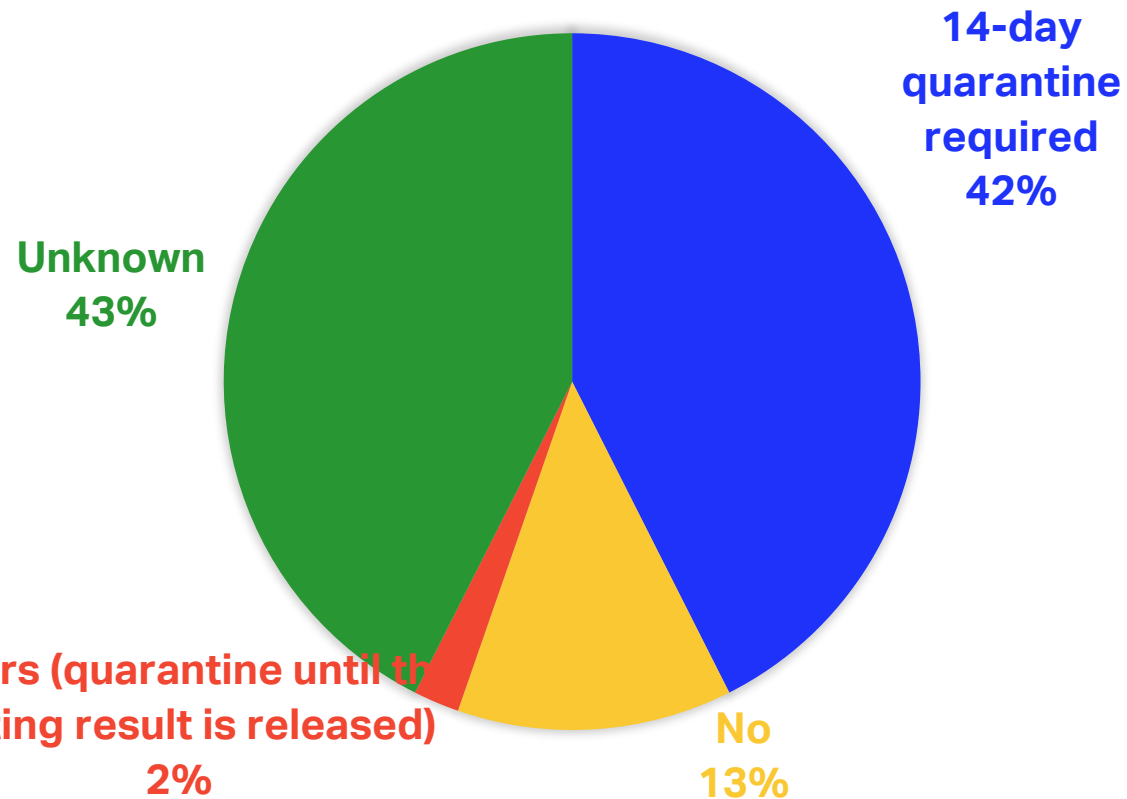


### Policies around crew COVID-19 testing:

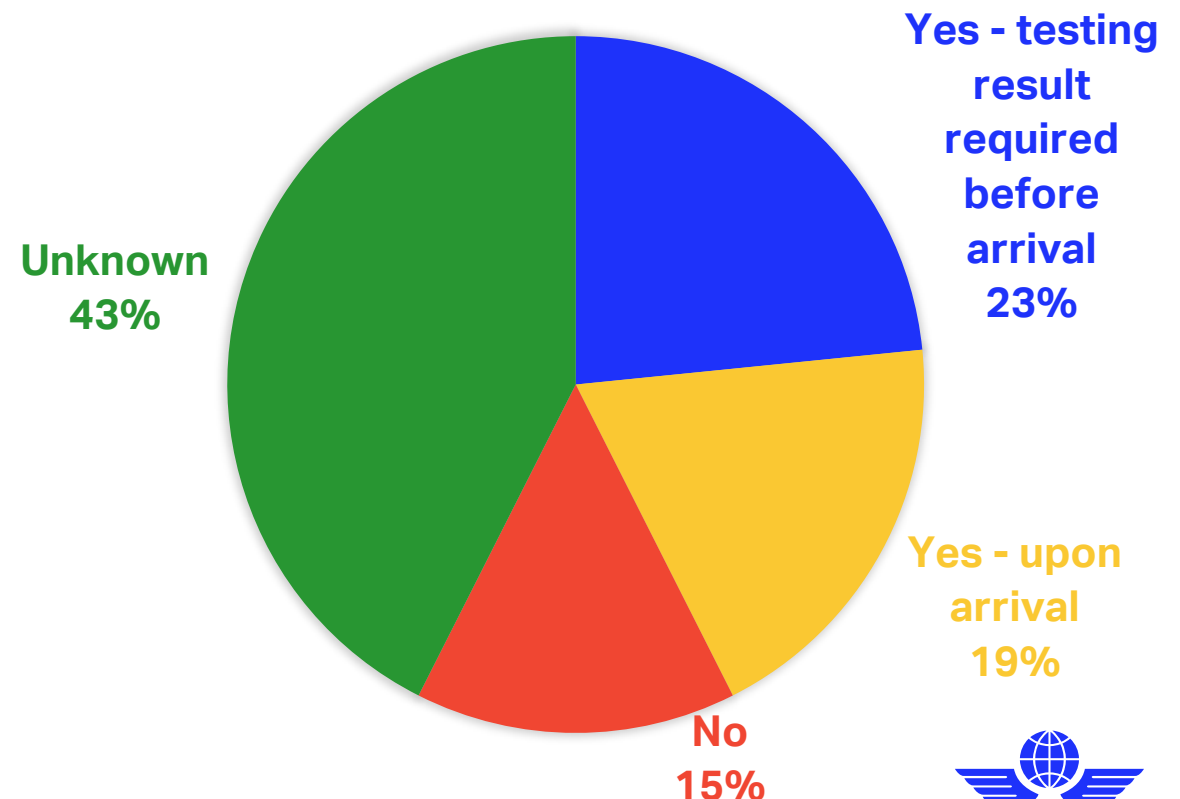
- Crew are tested in the same way passengers are tested upon arrival;
- Crew are tested in the hotel;
- Crew must hold a negative COVID-19 PCR testing result same as passengers;
- Layover crew are allowed to leave the country even though the result has not been released;

## QUARANTINE MEASURES IN PLACE

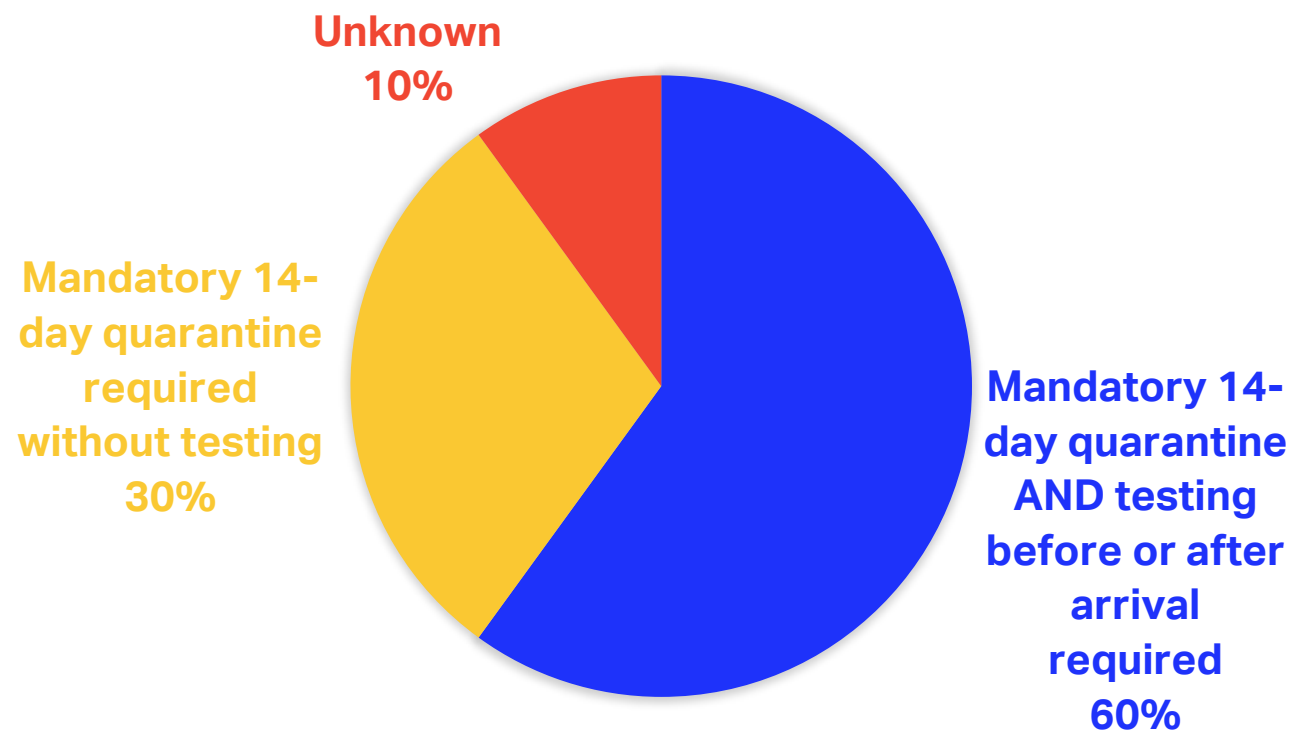

# Are quarantine and COVID-19 testing measures well balanced?

## COMBINATION OF QUARANTINE AND TESTING MEASURES



Among the countries where a 14-day quarantine is required, 60% require COVID-19 testing (usually PCR testing) either before or after arrival; those cases where a testing is required right before completing the 14-day quarantine are not counted in this chart.

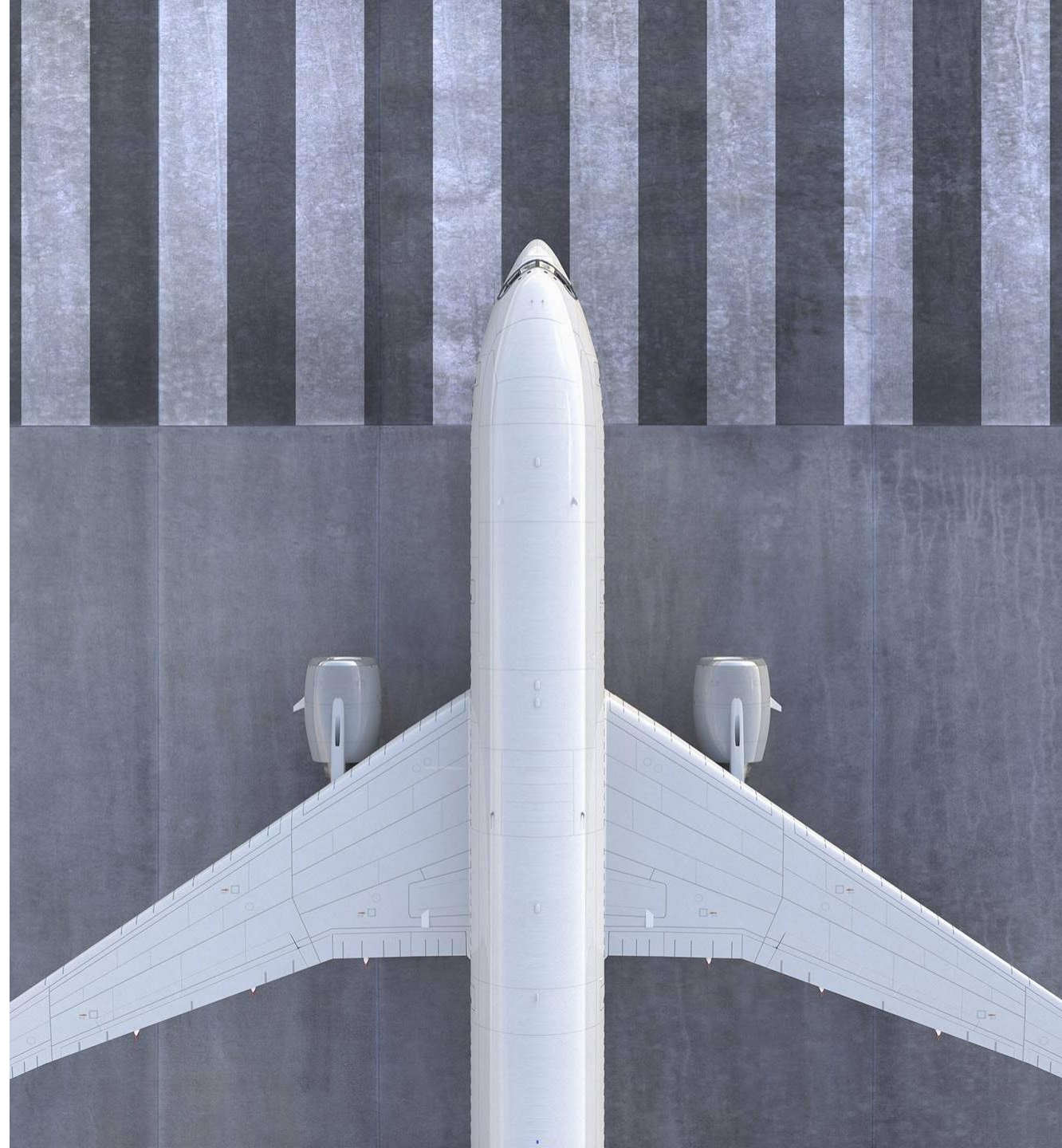
