- Completed on 27 May 2020
- Approved by the Council during the 220th Session 2<sup>nd</sup> Meeting  
(Monday, 1 June, 2020)
- Two parts to the Report:
  - Report (in executive summary format with 15 Pages) containing 11 recommendations
  - Take-off: Guidance for Air Travel through the COVID-19 Public Health Crisis (Technical Guidance with 48 Pages)



- The report mentions that the **level of implementation** of the **measures** contained therein will need to be regularly monitored by ICAO.
- In playing this role, ICAO will **facilitate** the **sharing of information** and experience among States and should facilitate the identification of **gaps** and **needed support**.
- Through this information, ICAO will be able to provide appropriate, targeted and timely **guidance, training** and **assistance** to Member States, mainly by means of implementation packages, for the effective implementation of measures outlined in the report.



- The COVID-19 Response and Recovery Implementation Center (CRRIC) is a **system** of different **resources** and **products** directly managed by the ICAO Secretariat
- The information collected will be used to **report** on the effectiveness and completeness of implementation support activities and feed the relevant groups within the Secretariat responsible for the development of specific implementation packages as well as the Council
- The COVID-19 Response and Recovery Implementation Center is a **transparent, comprehensive** and **project oriented tool**, with links to the Resource Mobilization Platform, which would enable ICAO to **support** States in their implementation efforts and facilitate **monitoring** and reporting of States' levels of implementation as well as challenges faced



- A list of **focal points** in regions and Member States coordinating the implementation of the CART recommendations- in coordination with ROs;
- An email **support** hotline (coordinated by HQs and RO) and a frequently asked questions to respond to questions coming from Member States in relation to the CART
- A **gap analysis** tool allowing Member States to self-assess their status with respect to the measures contained in the CART report and define actions plans;
- An **information sharing** tool allowing Member States to share best practices and solutions
- A **dashboard** monitoring the level of implementation of the various measures worldwide.
- A **database of measures** to select and share public health measure taken in relation to the Take-off Document



## **Development and Test**

- By end June, the different components of the tool will be developed
- An ICAO secretariat group was created to define the components

## **Release**

- A State letter will be issued informing the States on the availability of the center
- Focal points will need to be nominated by States
- Release is planned for early July
- Continuous improvements will be done

The CRRIC is hosted on the **ICAO Secure Portal** allowing secure access and protection of information
